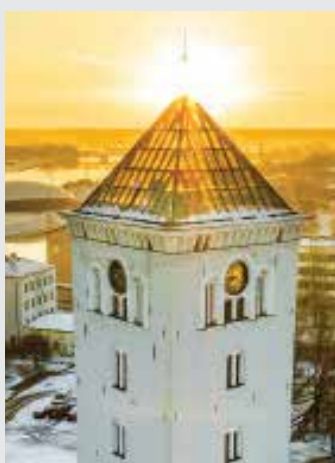

Dear readers of the publication “Jelgava in figures 2023”!



In 2023, the primary task of the Jelgava State City Council remained unchanged – the people of Jelgava should feel increasingly safe and comfortable in their city. This represents stability in areas important to residents, such as public infrastructure, the quality of education, access to culture, as well as economic development and employment.

In 2023, the conditions for receiving loans for municipal investment projects changed nationwide. Despite this challenge, we initiated several projects important to the residents of Jelgava. One of the most anticipated was the reconstruction of Aizsargu Street and the roundabout. In 2023 The section of Aizsargu Street up to the city border has been renewed, and asphalt has been laid on the roundabout.

Demonstrating that education is a priority for Jelgava, we opened a new municipal preschool education institution “Alnītis” for more than 160 children in the spring, and in September, we inaugurated the most modern secondary school for engineering sciences in the country – Jelgava Technology Secondary School.

In 2023, the reconstruction and equipping of the building at 47A Zirgu Street was completed, creating a modern multifunctional social service centre. At the city hospital, the unfinished maternity ward was demolished, freeing up space for the construction of a new department building.

We continued the implementation of several previously started projects. The largest of these is the reconstruction of Pilssalas Street and the construction of a modern water tourism and sports base on the banks of the Lielupe River, as well as the reconstruction and equipping of the building at 32 Pasta Street for the needs of the Jelgava City and District Registry Office.

To offer new industrial areas to entrepreneurs, we plan to implement the Zemgale Industrial Park project by revitalising the degraded former airfield area, creating preconditions for new job creation and attracting private investment.

Our collective strength lies in our ability to carry out projects aimed at the development of the city and the creation of a city environment that is friendly to its residents and businesses.

I invite you to explore the facts and figures that describe the developments in the city’s economic, cultural, social and sports life!

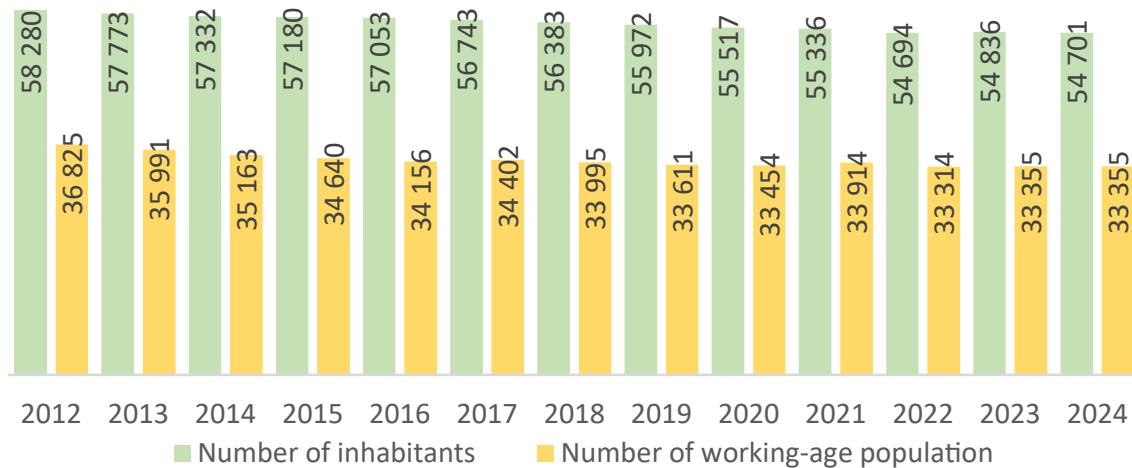

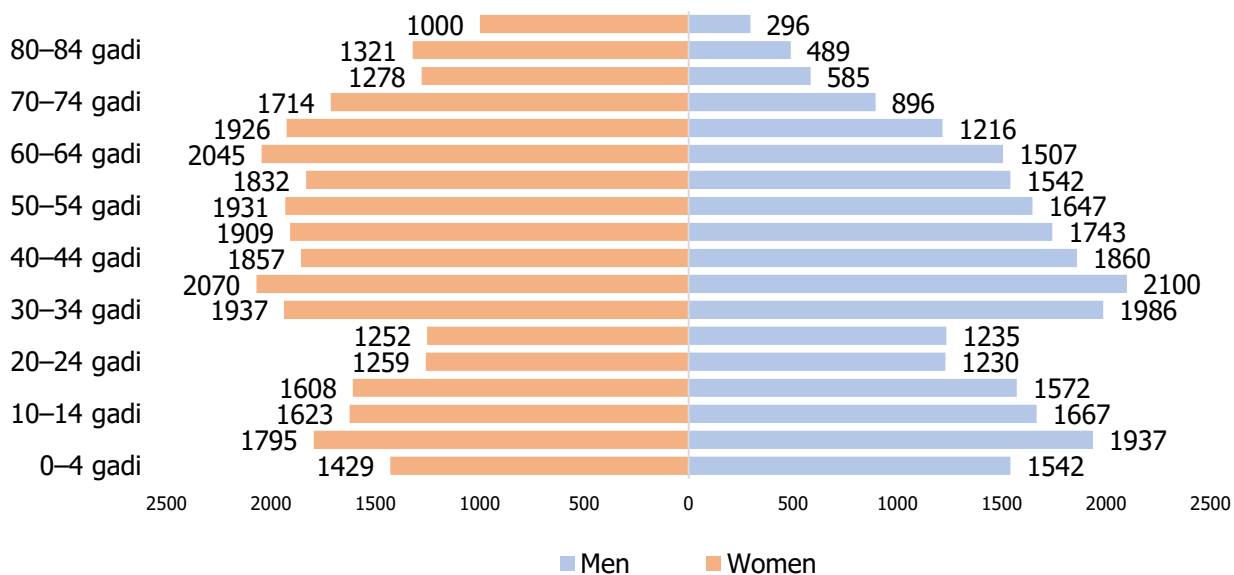

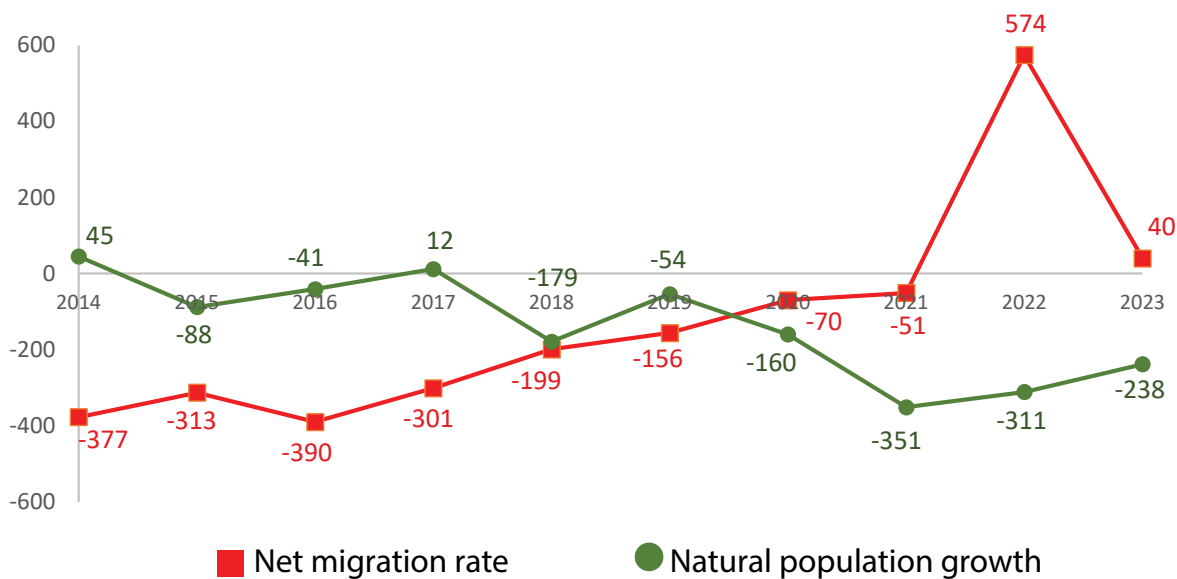
Age and gender structure of Jelgava residents at the beginning of 2024

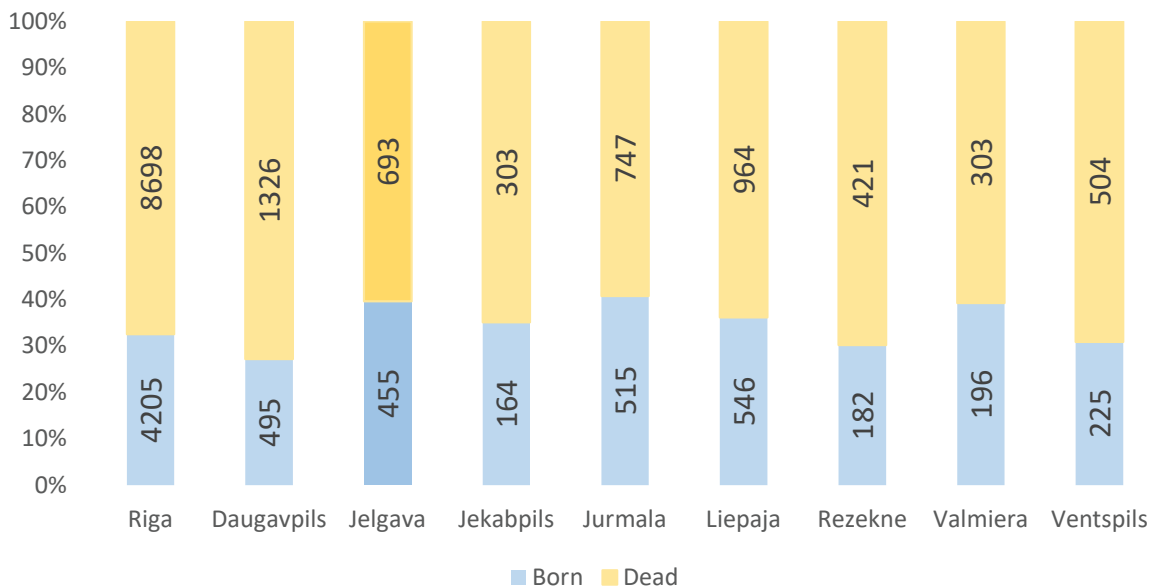

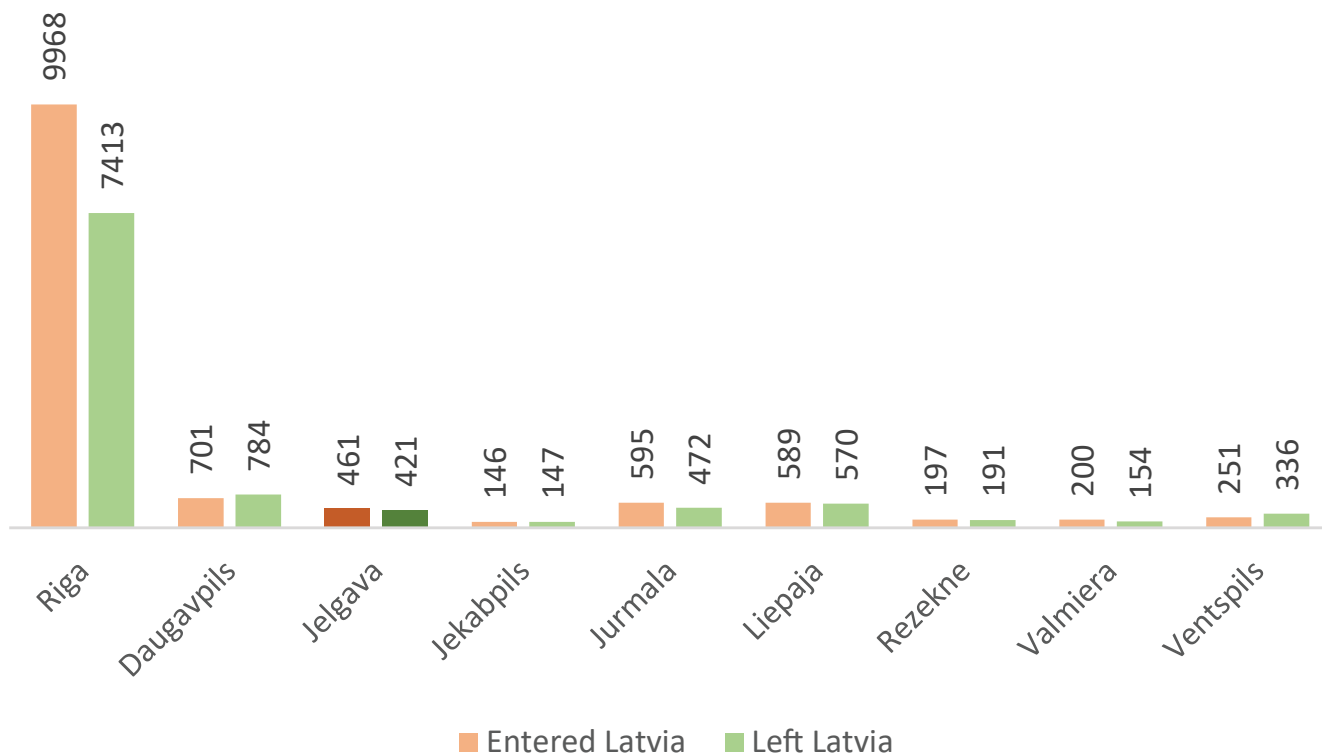


Number and proportion of births and deaths in national cities in 2023

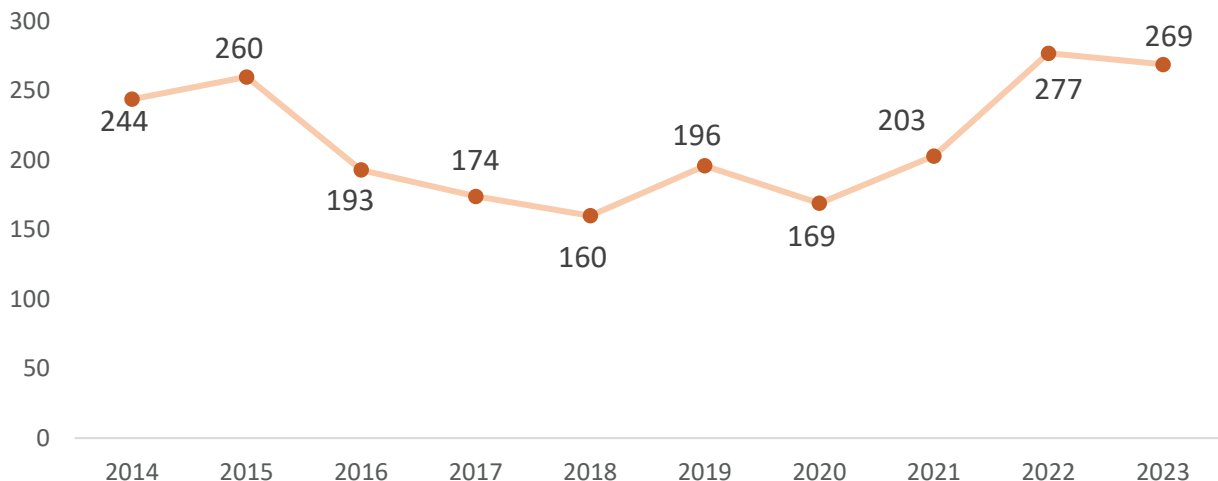
The number of residents who moved in and out of state cities in 2023

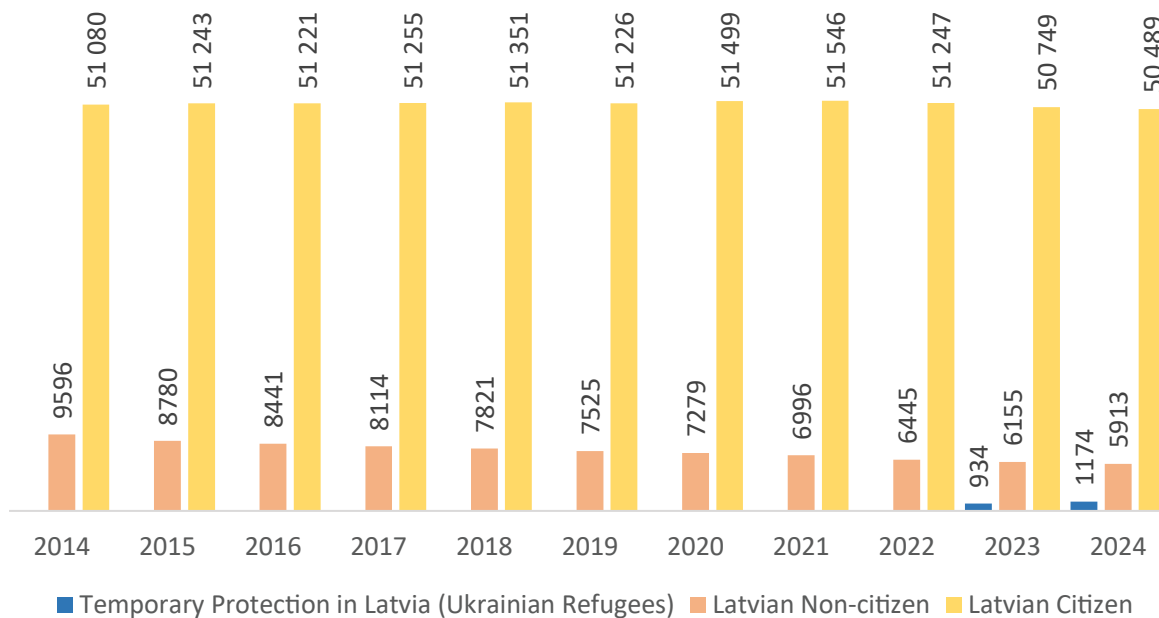
Number of remigrants* in Jelgava

The population of Jelgava by nationality*, at the beginning of the year

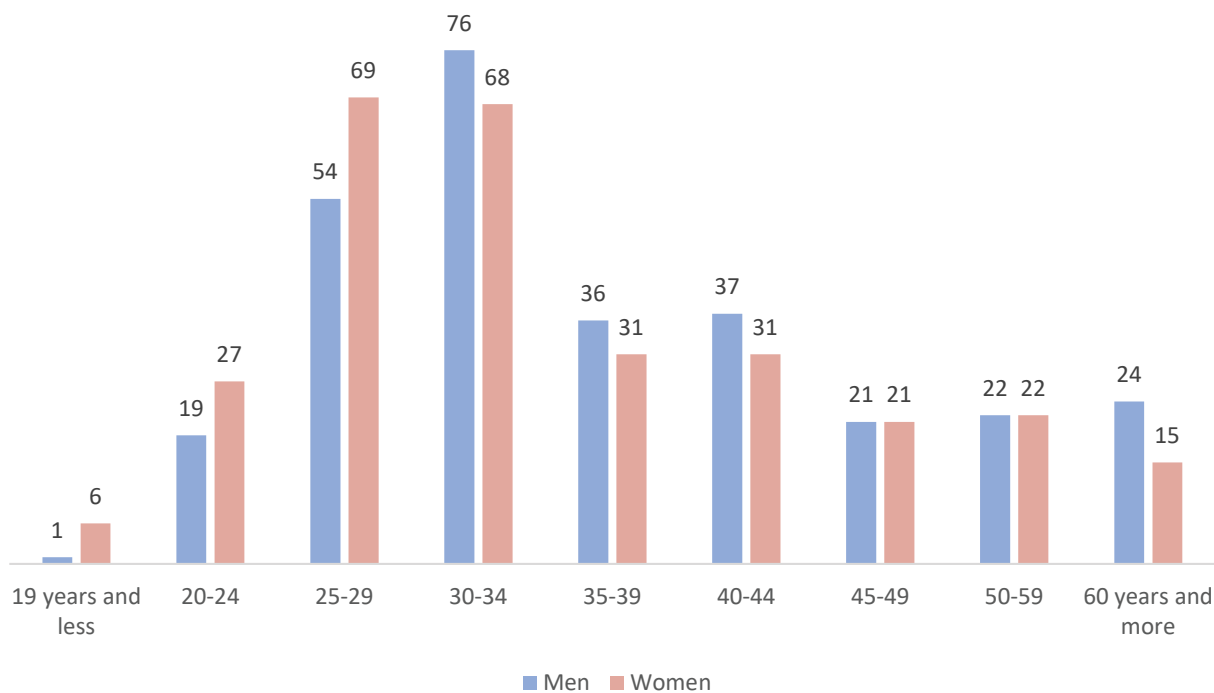

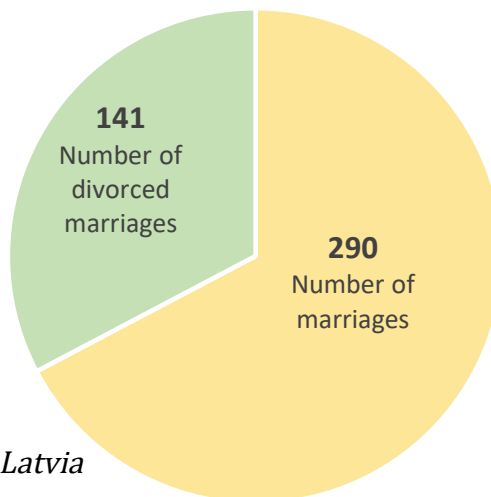


The number of marriages by the gender of the spouses and by age groups



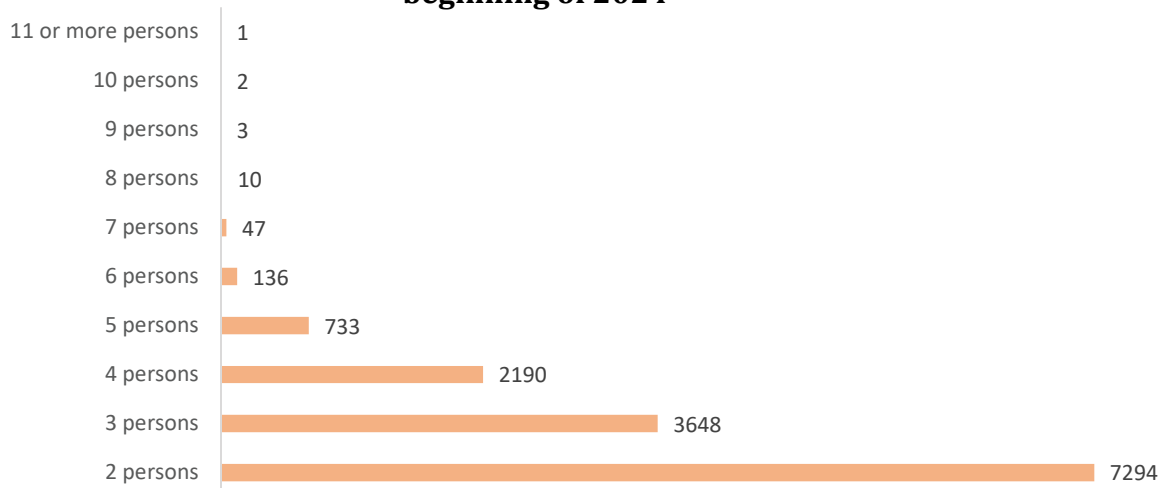

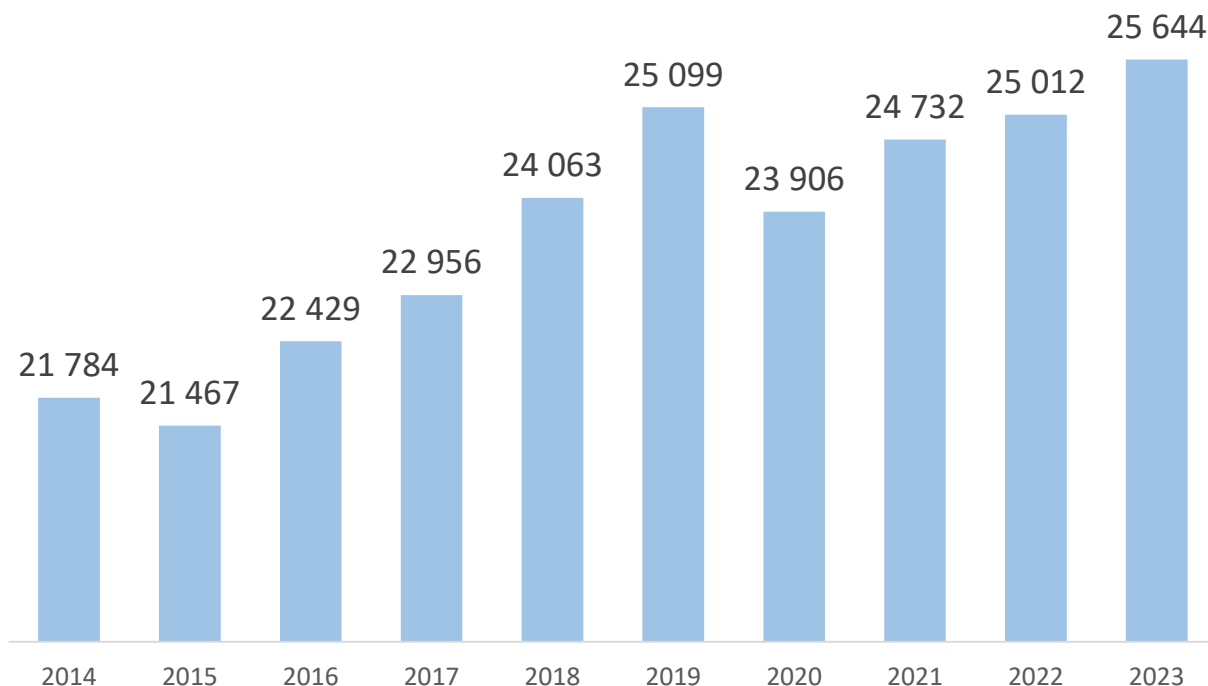

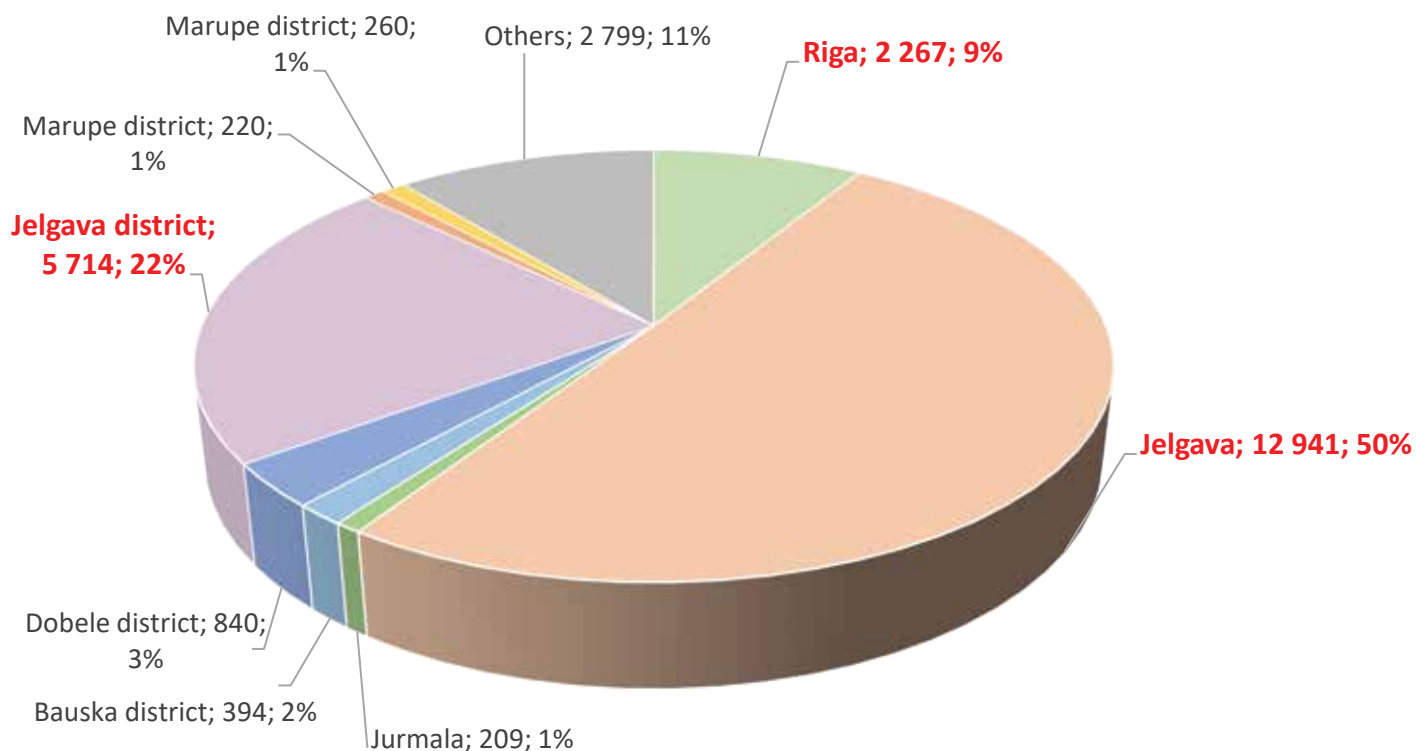

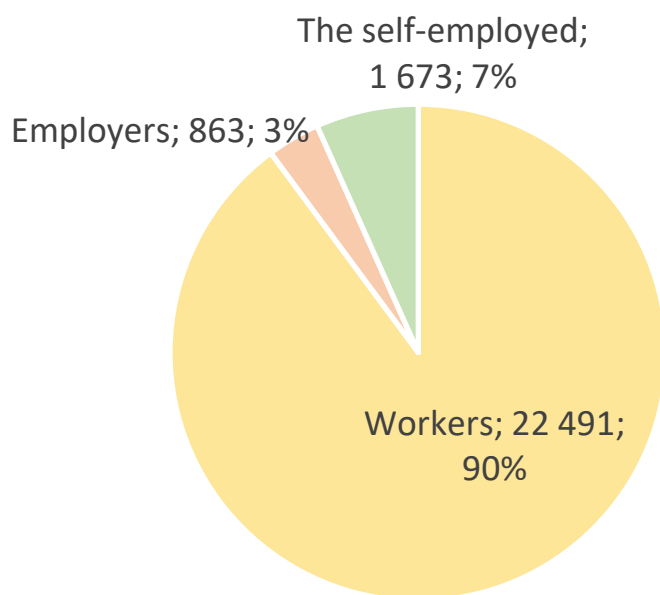
The number of people working in Jelgava by place of residence in 2023

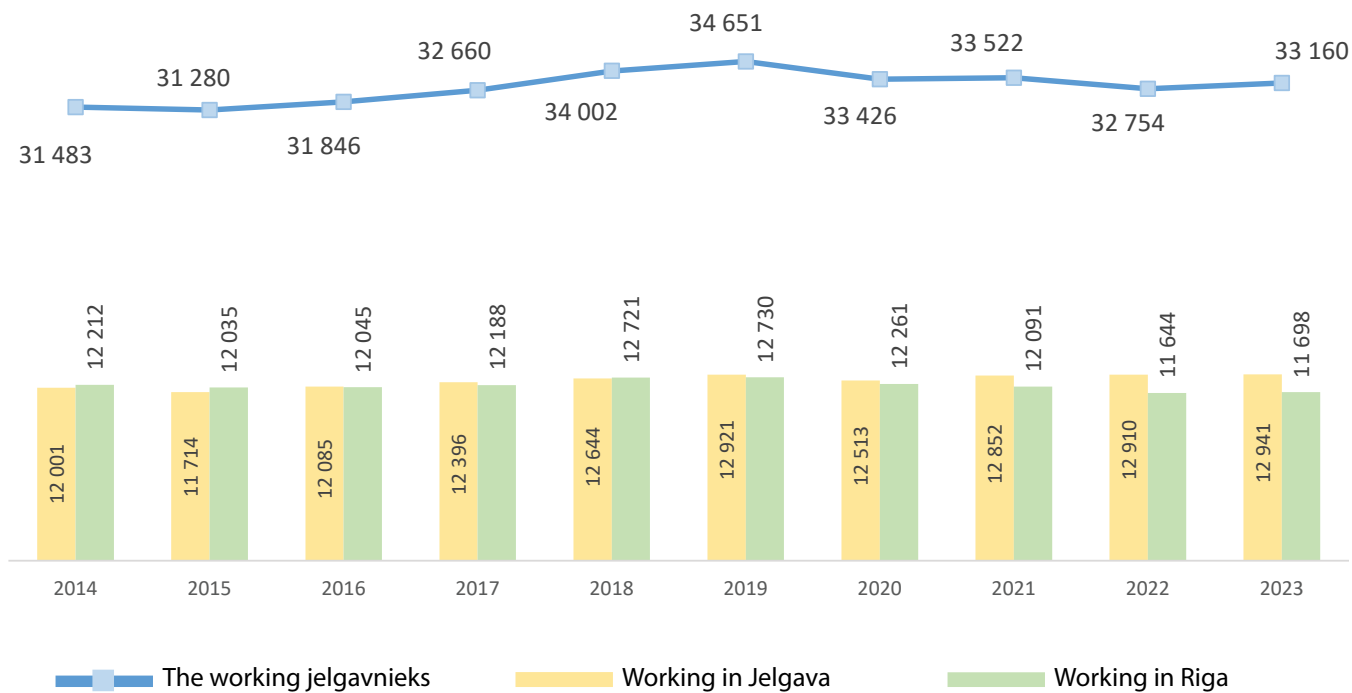


Employees by employment status in Jelgava in 2023

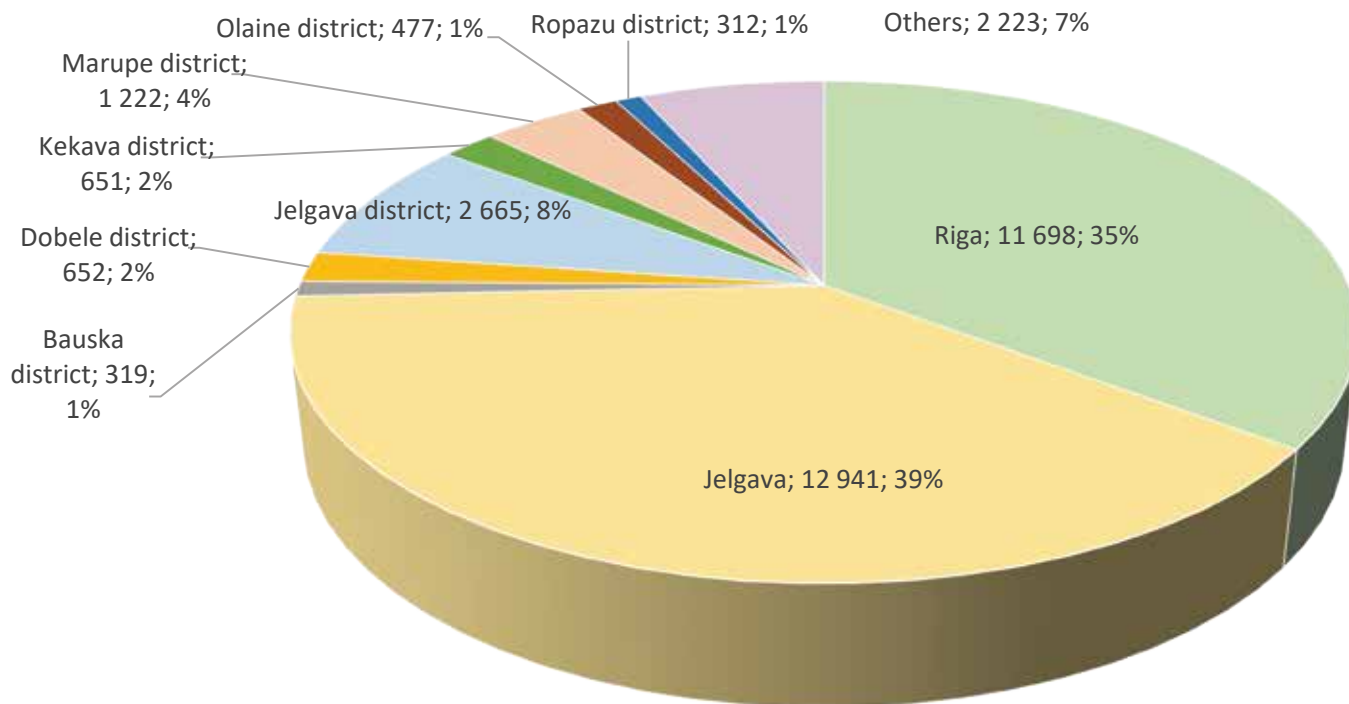
The number of working Jelgava inhabitants, incl. those working in Jelgava and Riga in 2014-2023

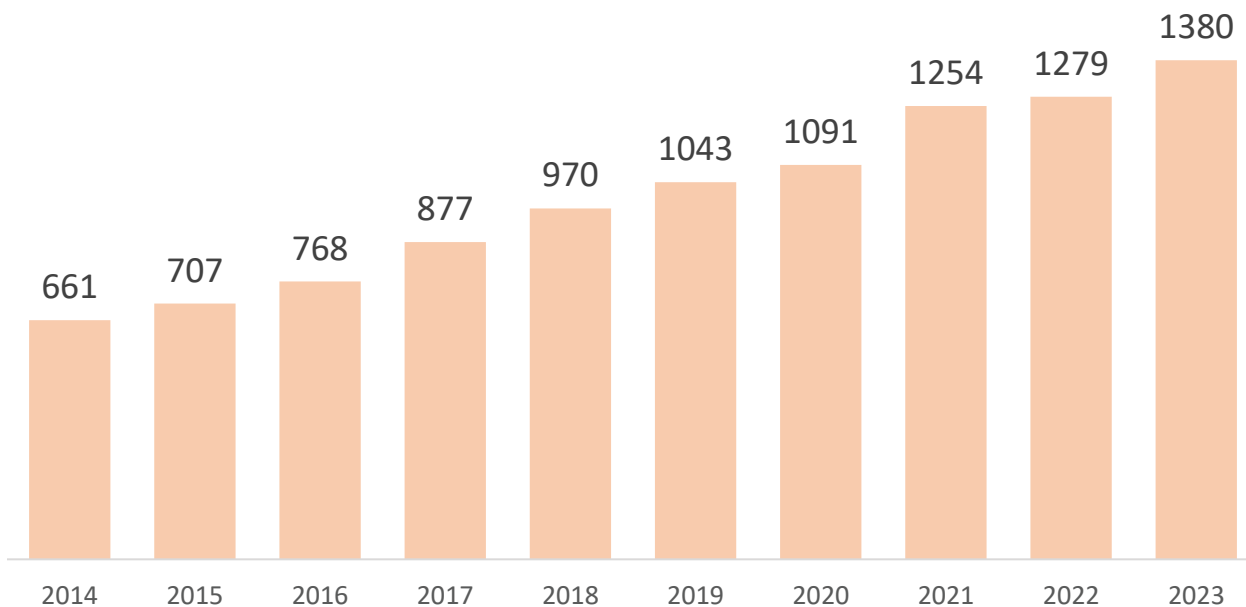


Working Jelgava inhabitants in the distribution by workplace areas in 2023

Average* gross salary euro in Jelgava 2021-2023

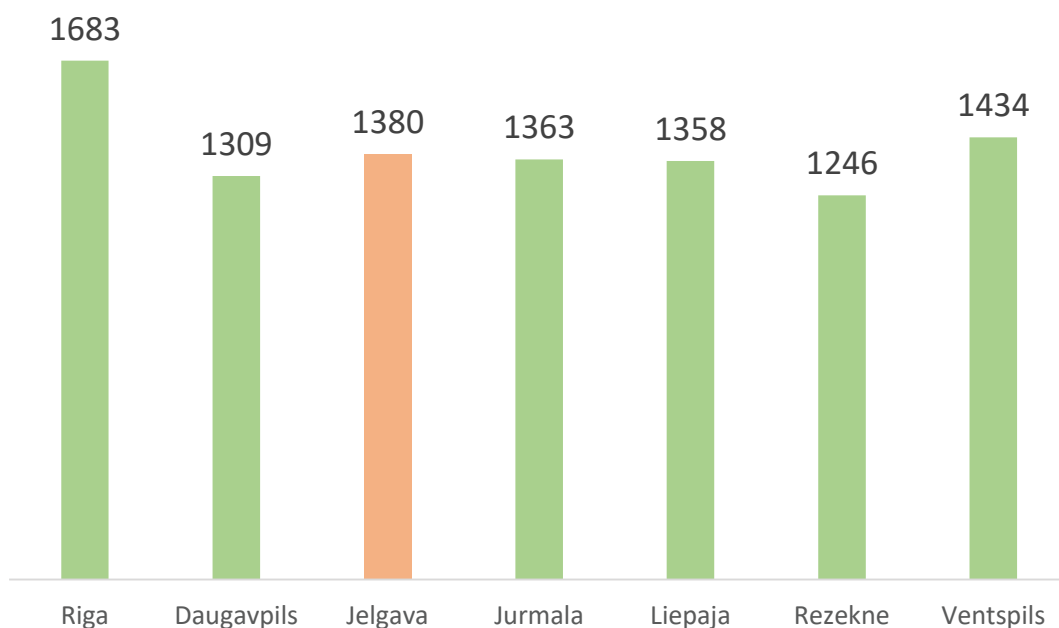

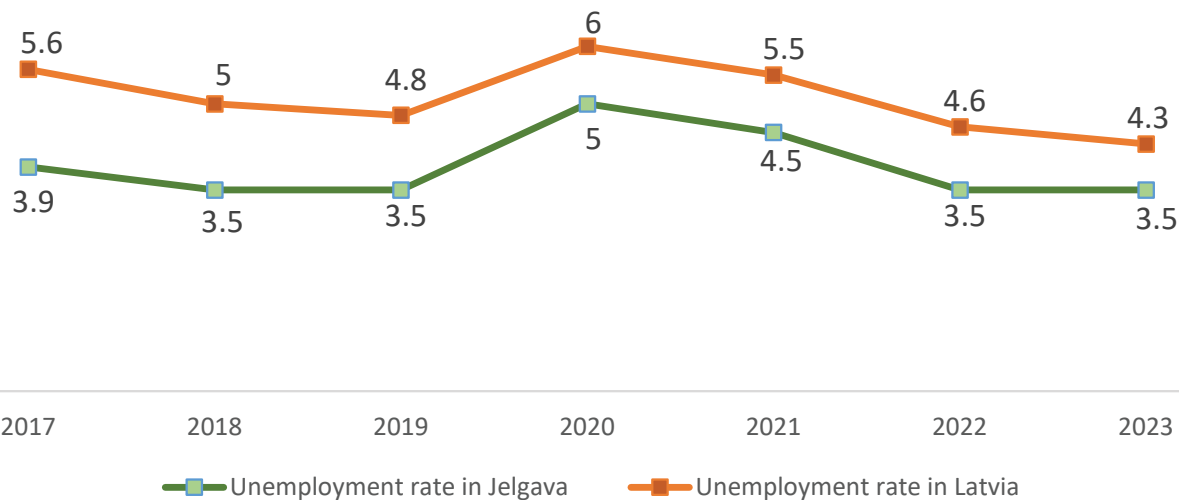
Average monthly gross salary *euro* of employees in state cities by sector 2022-2023

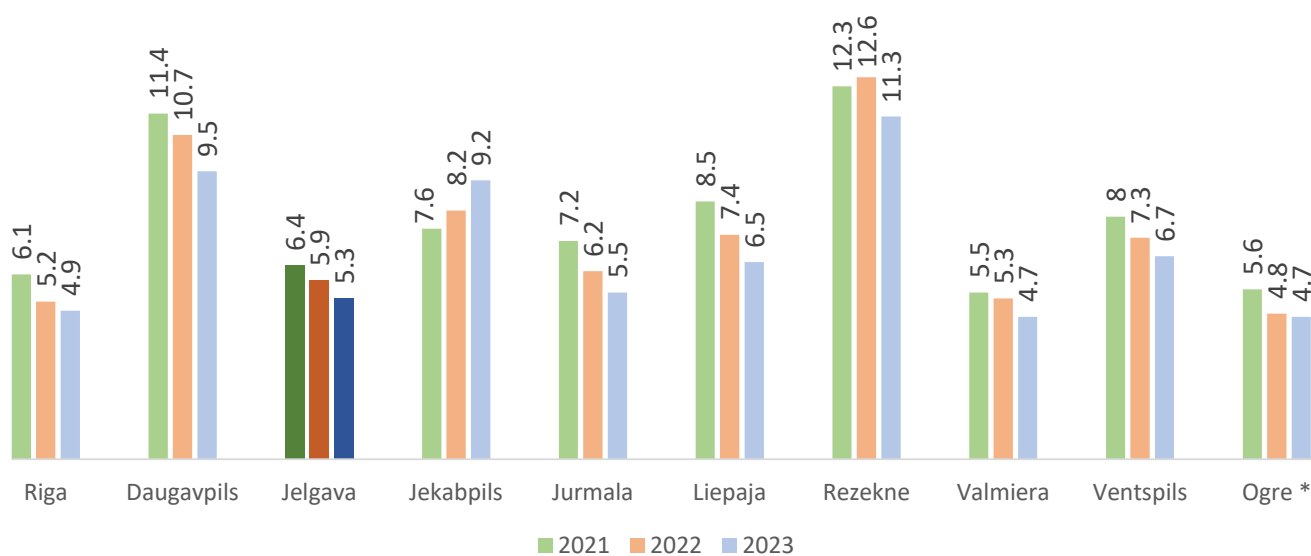


Unemployment rate in Jelgava compared to Latvia, 2017-2023

Unemployment rate % in national cities in 2021-2023

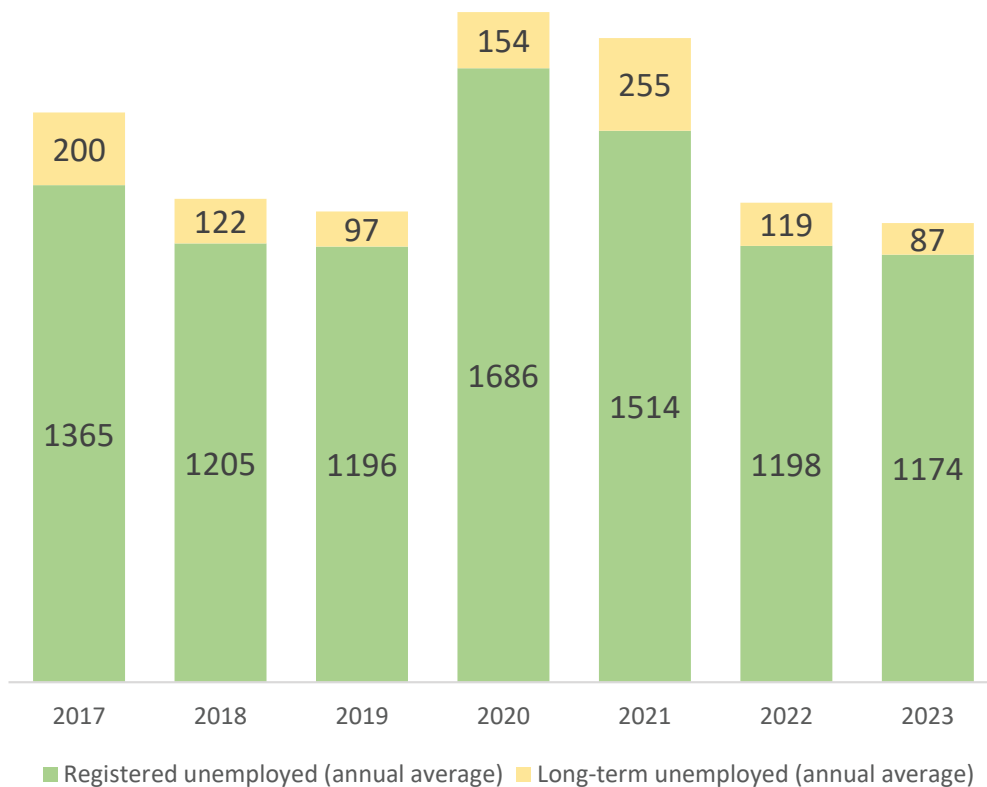

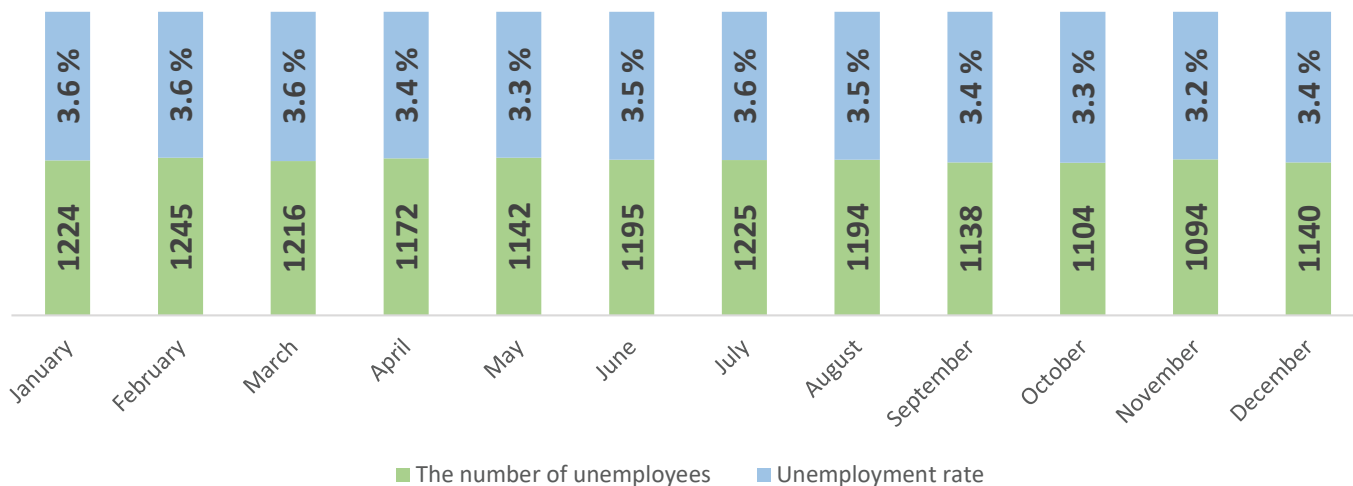


Number of registered unemployed and long-term unemployed in Jelgava 2017-2023

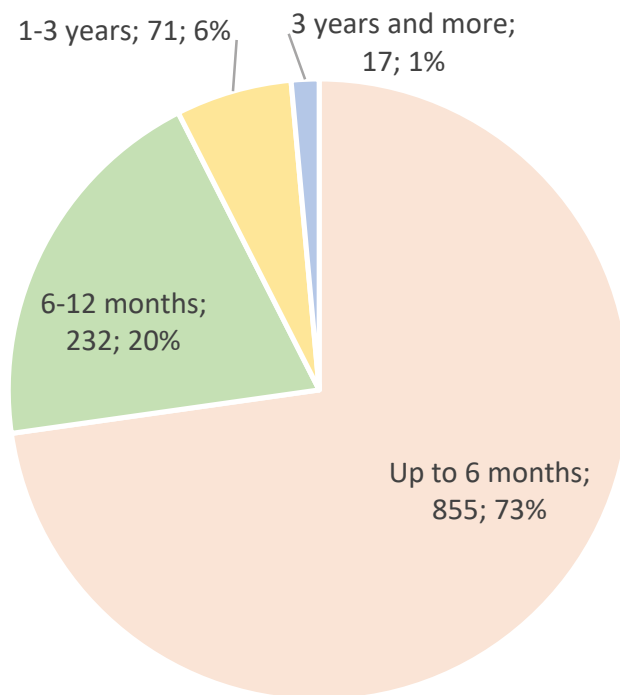
Unemployment rate and number of unemployed in Jelgava in 2023 by month

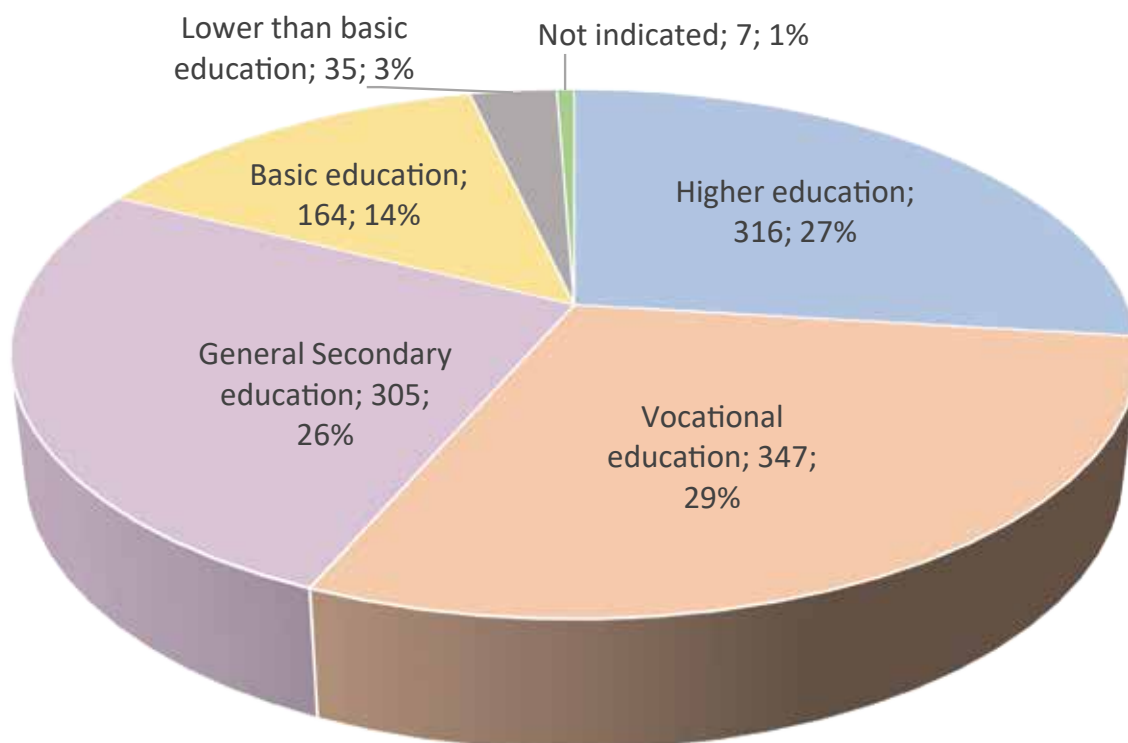


Duration of unemployment in Jelgava in 2023

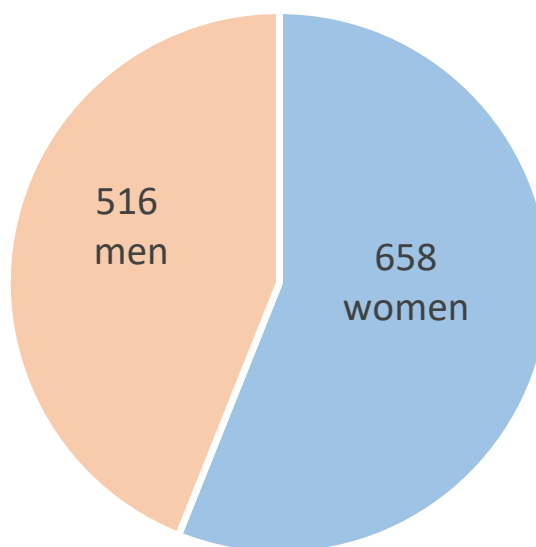
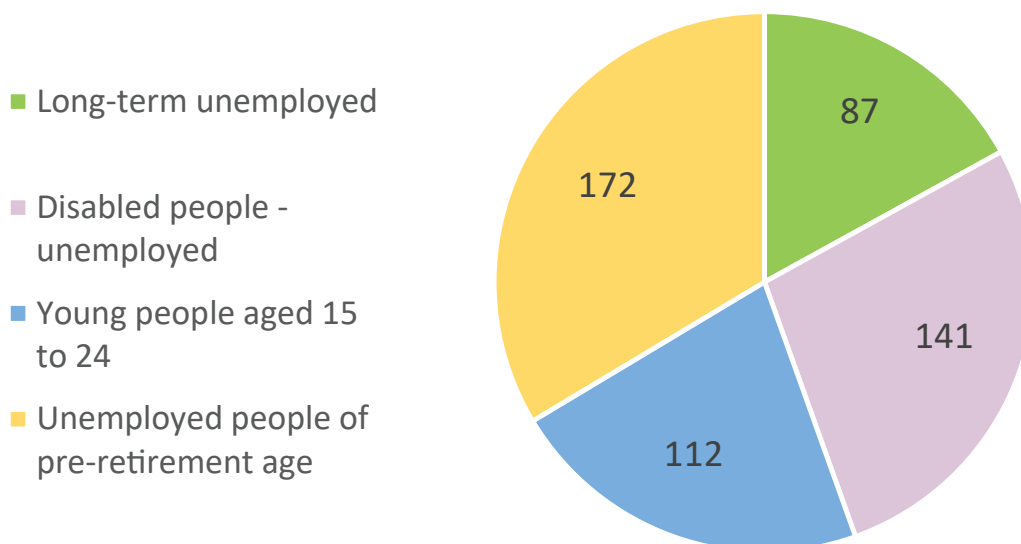
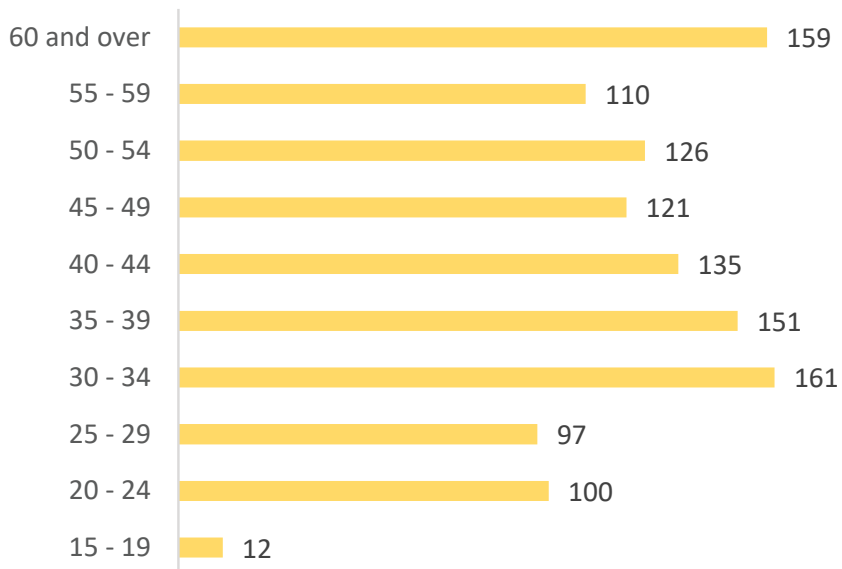
Education level of the unemployed in Jelgava in 2023

The number of registered unemployed in Jelgava by age groups, genders and problem groups in 2023

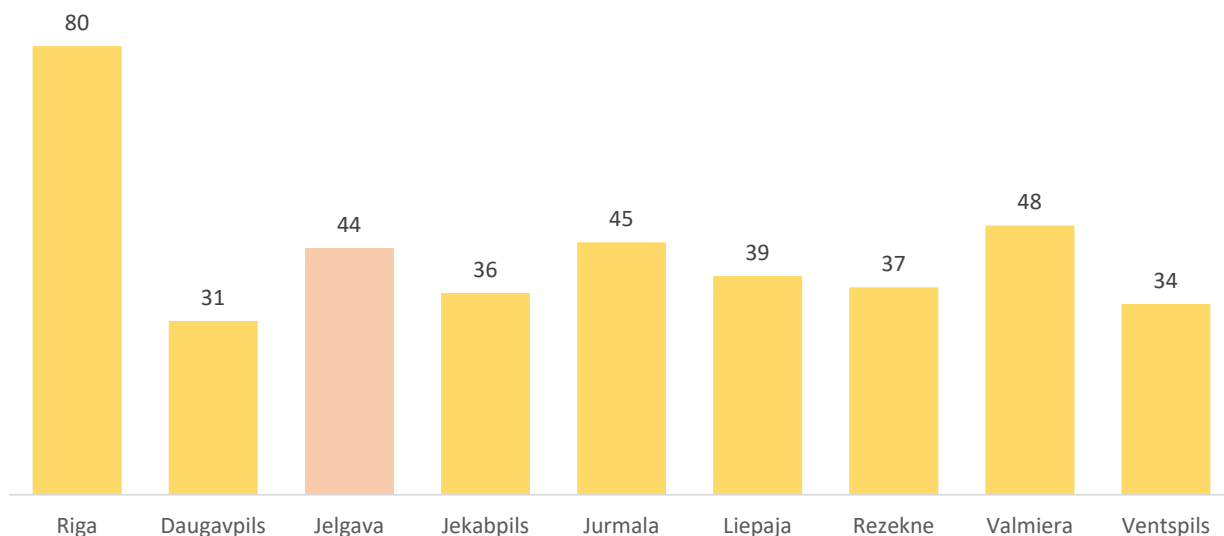

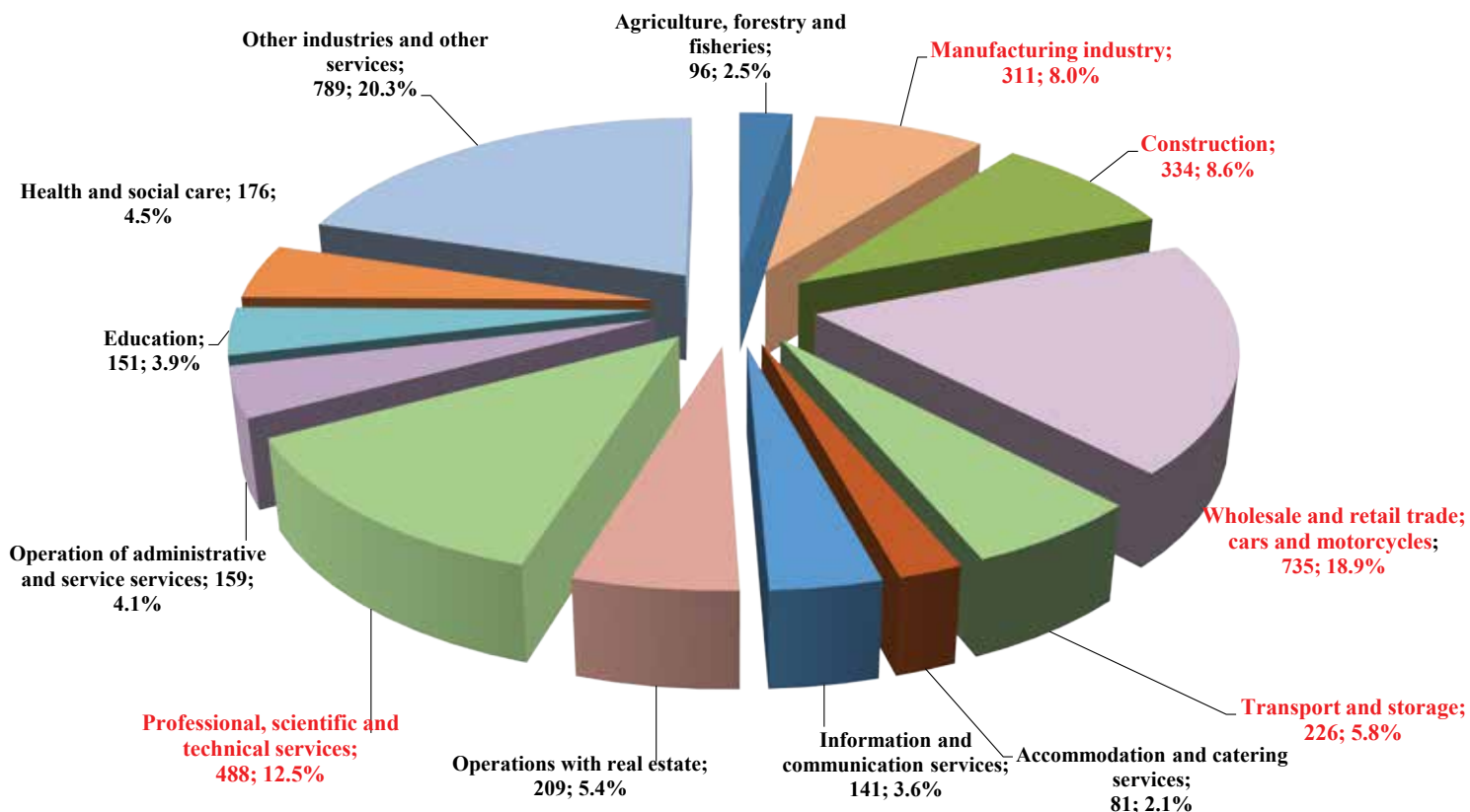

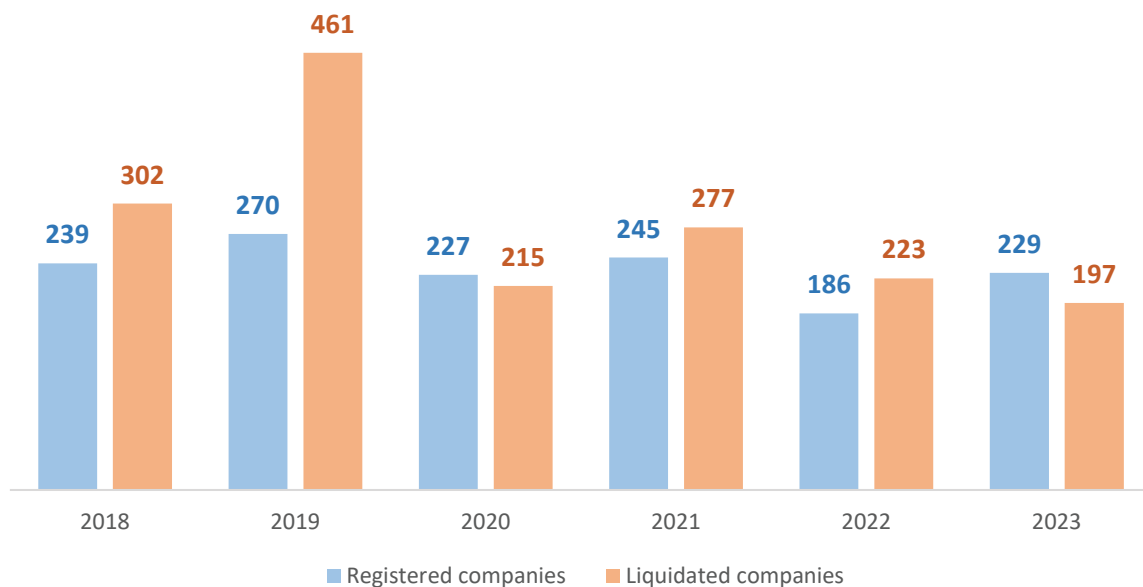
The number and proportion of economically active companies in the market sector in Jelgava, broken down by main types of activity in 2022

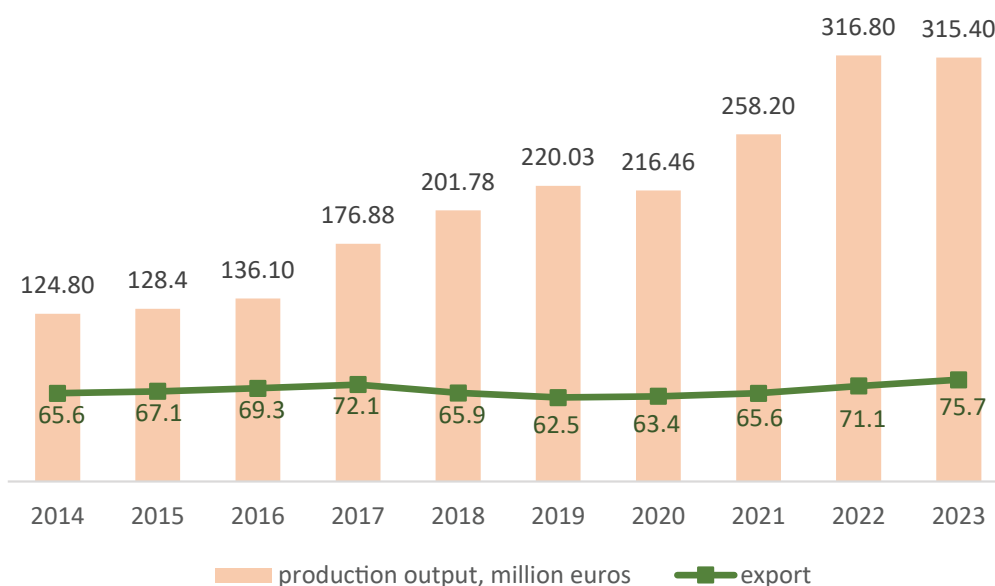

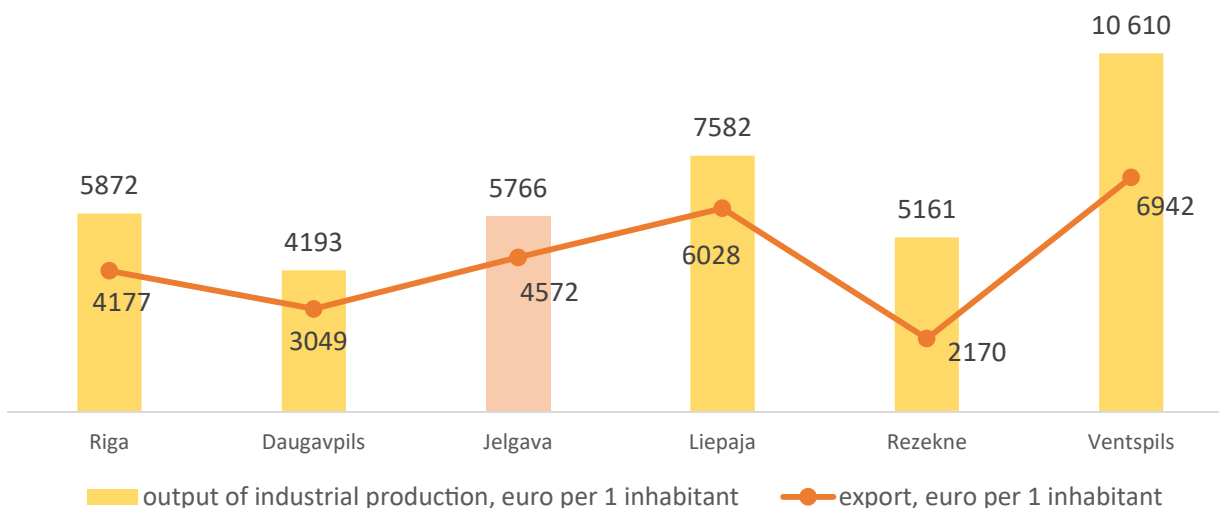

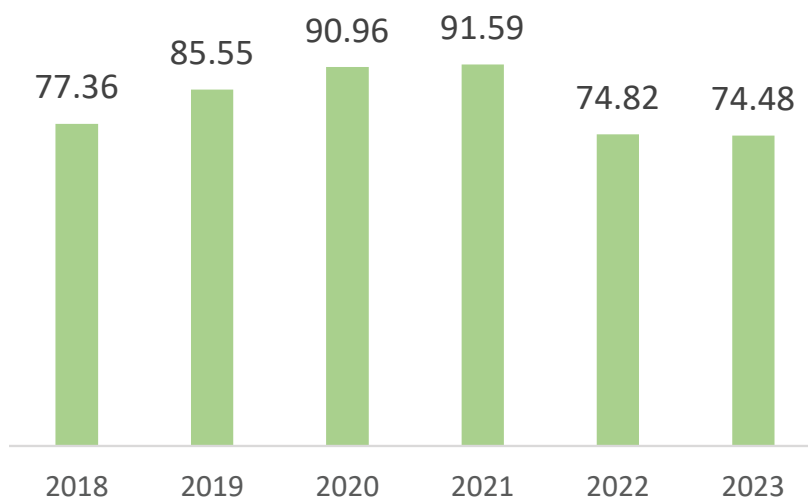

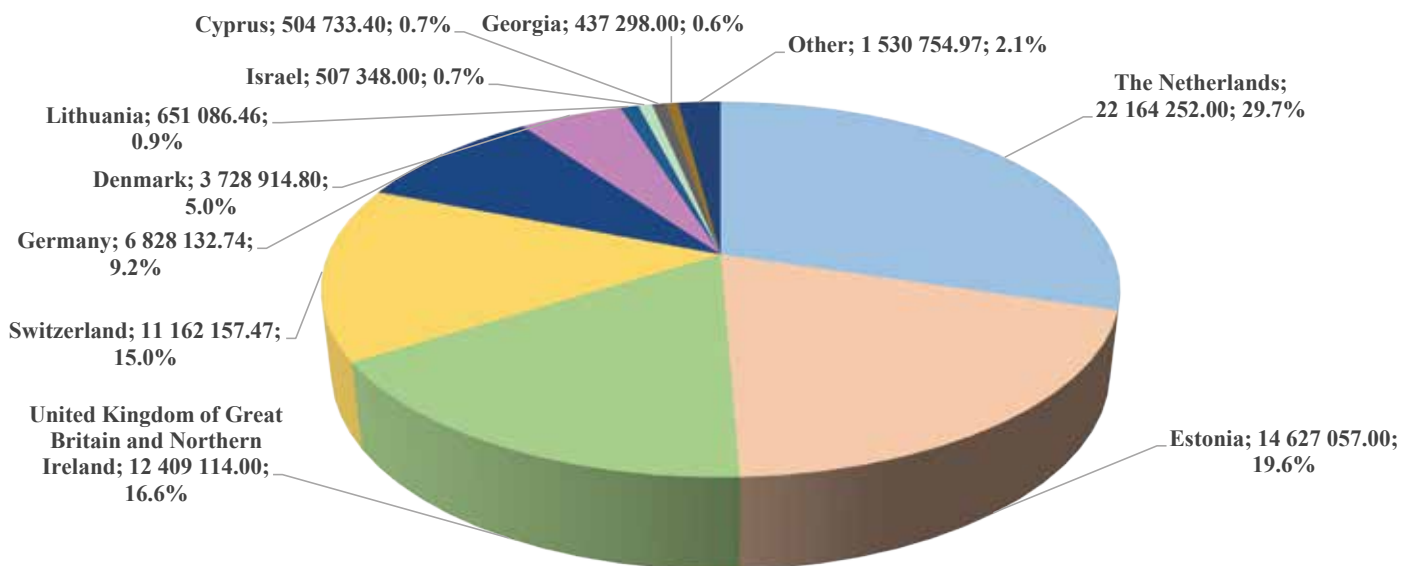


The amount of foreign investments accumulated in companies registered in Jelgava, mln. euro 2018-2023



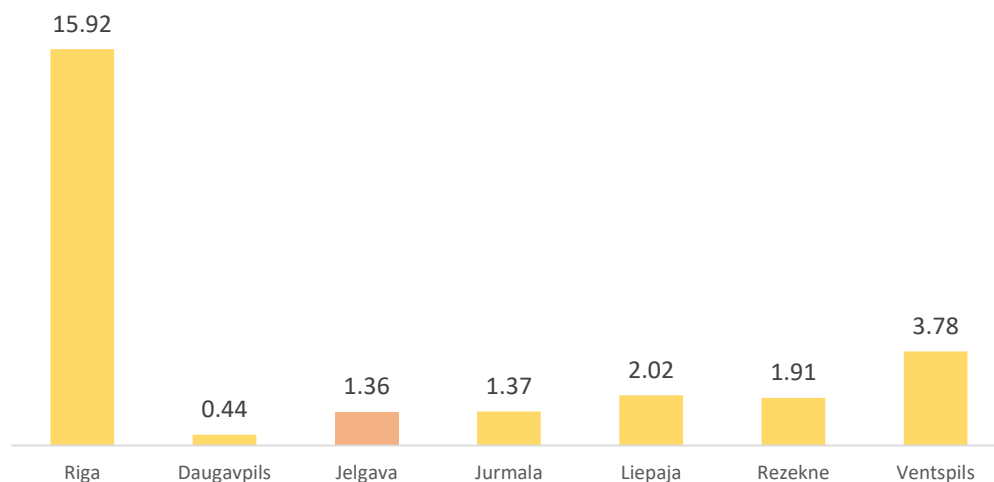

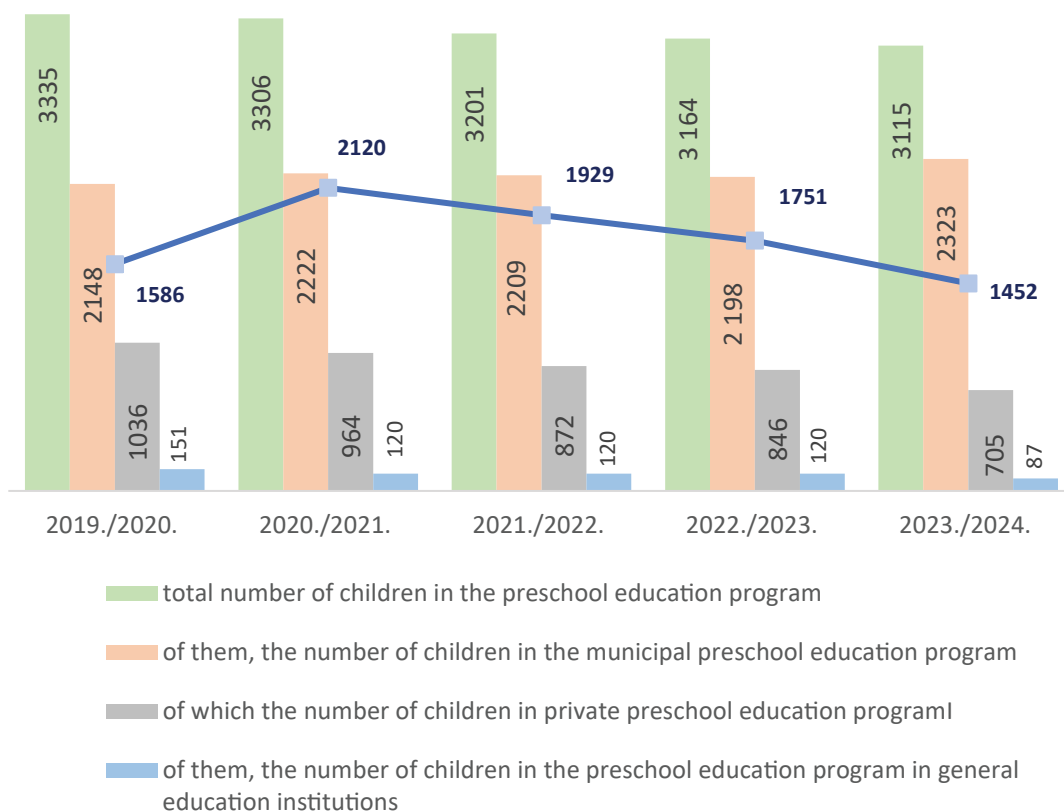

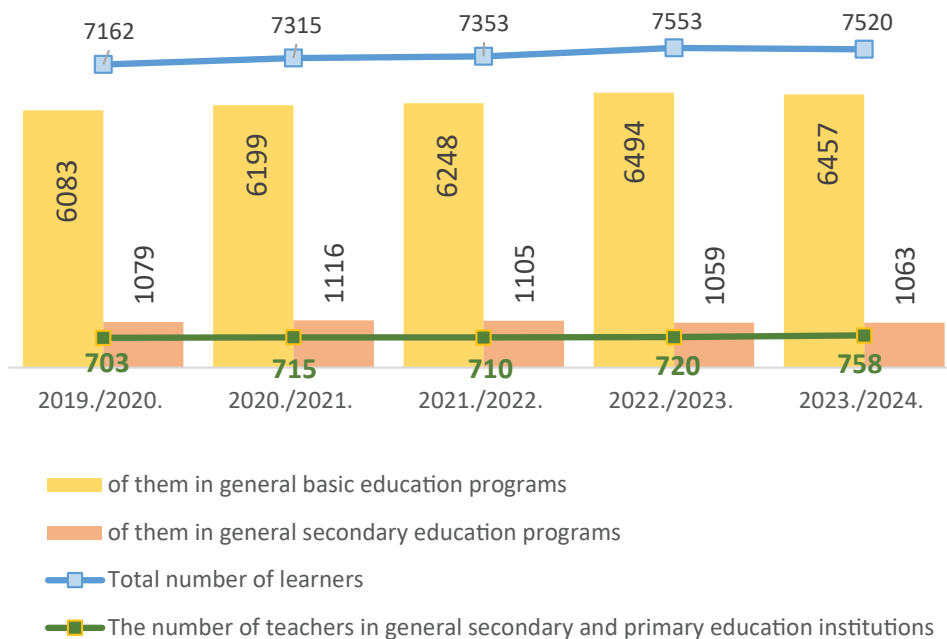

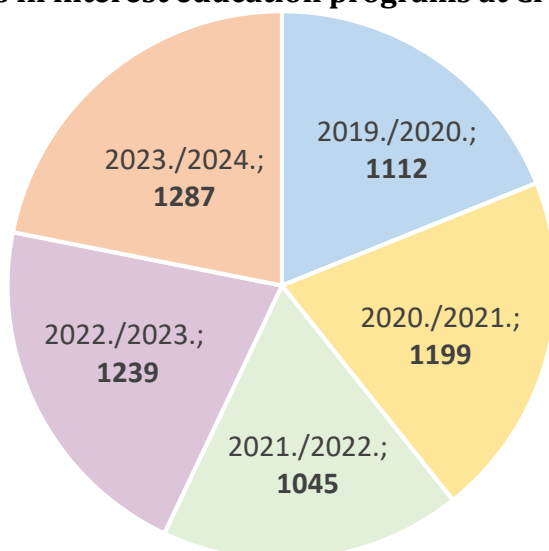

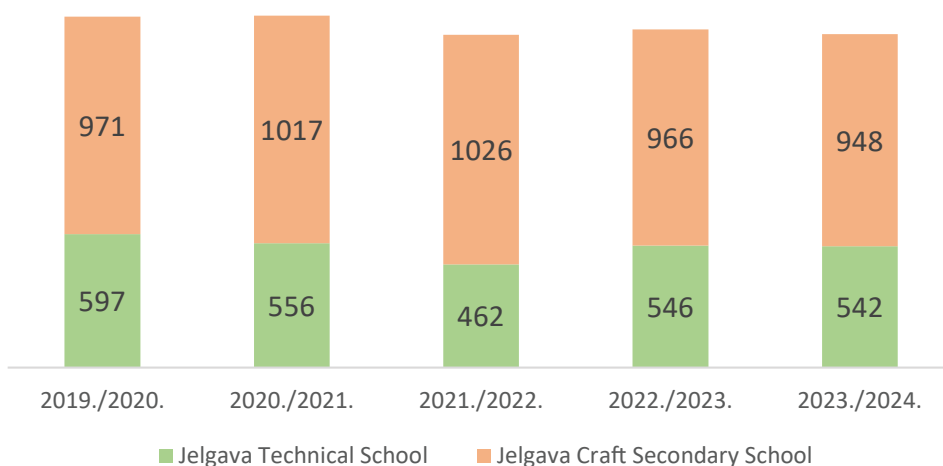


The number of students in interest education programs at Creative house “Junda”

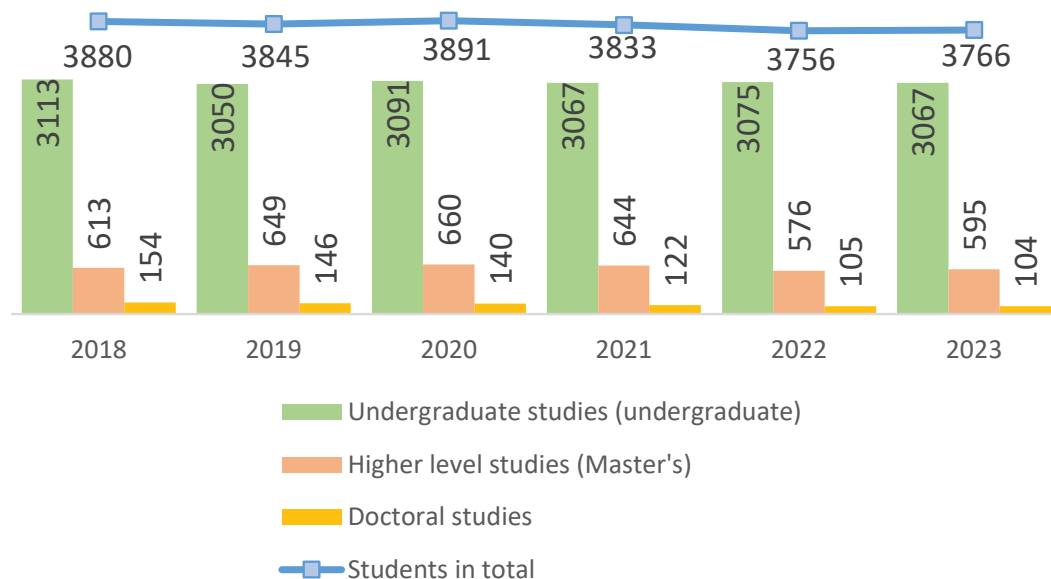

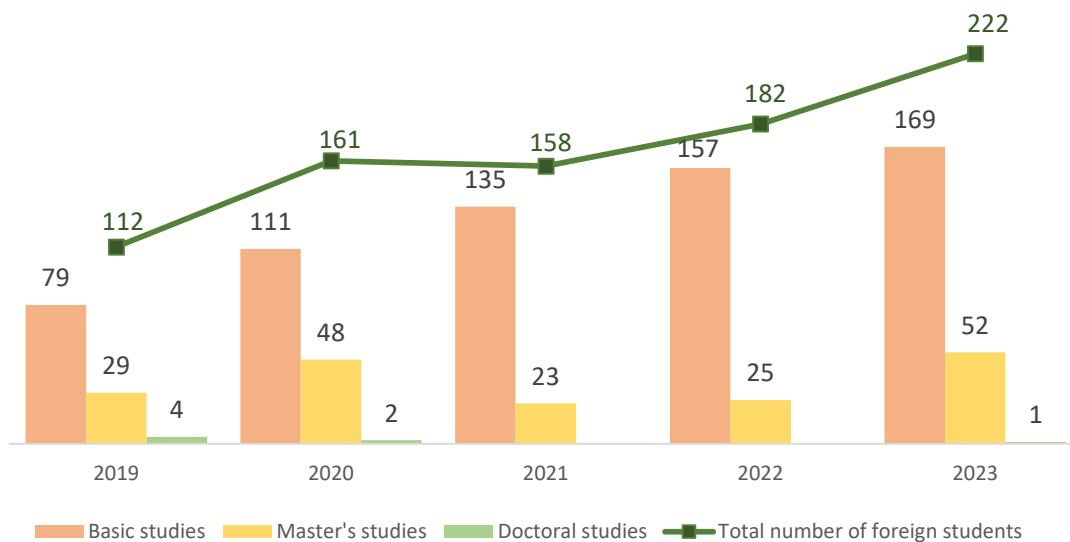


Number of students at the Latvia University of Life Sciences and Technologies 2018-2023

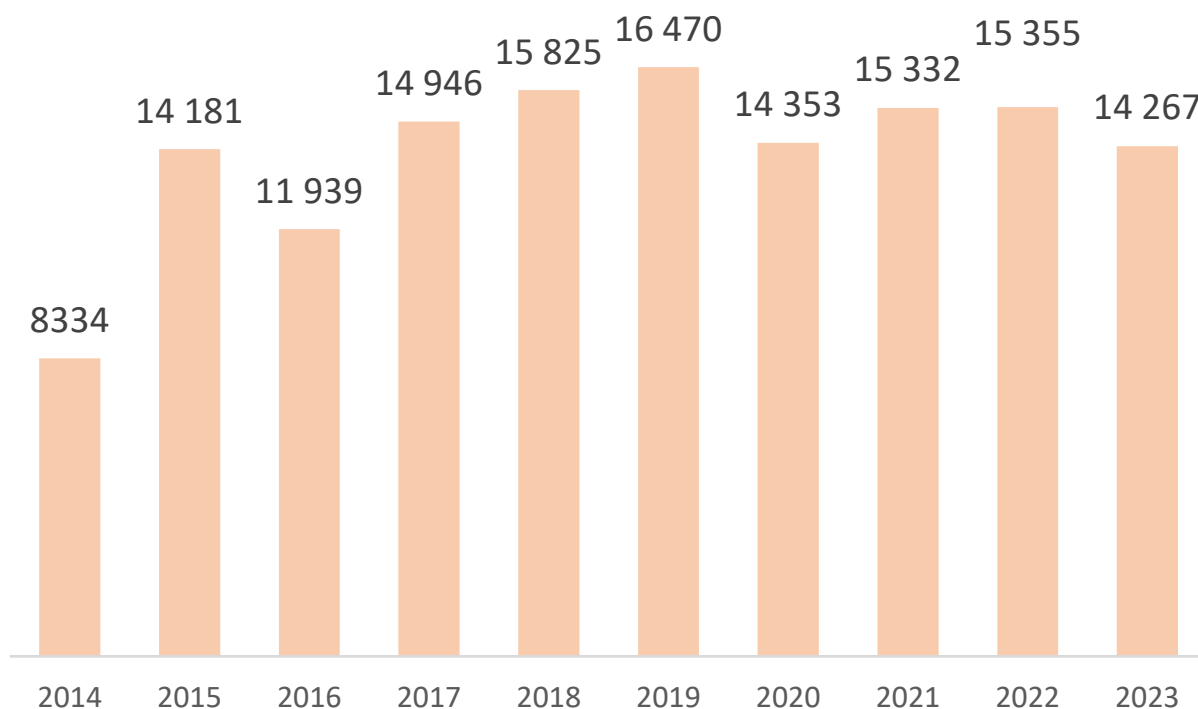
The number of foreign students at the Latvia University of Life Sciences and Technologies in 2019-2023

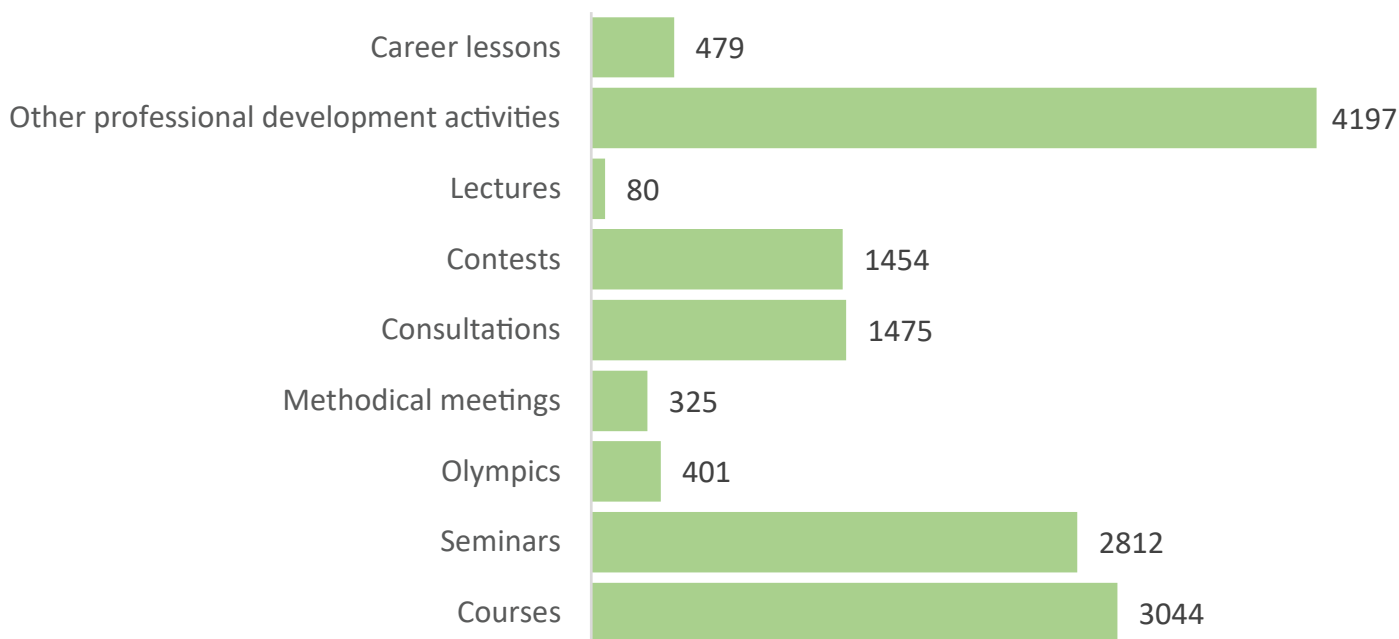


Dynamics of the number of participants in the events of the Competence Development Center of the Zemgale region in Jelgava 2014-2023

Number of participants by events organised by Competence Development Center of the Zemgale region in 2023

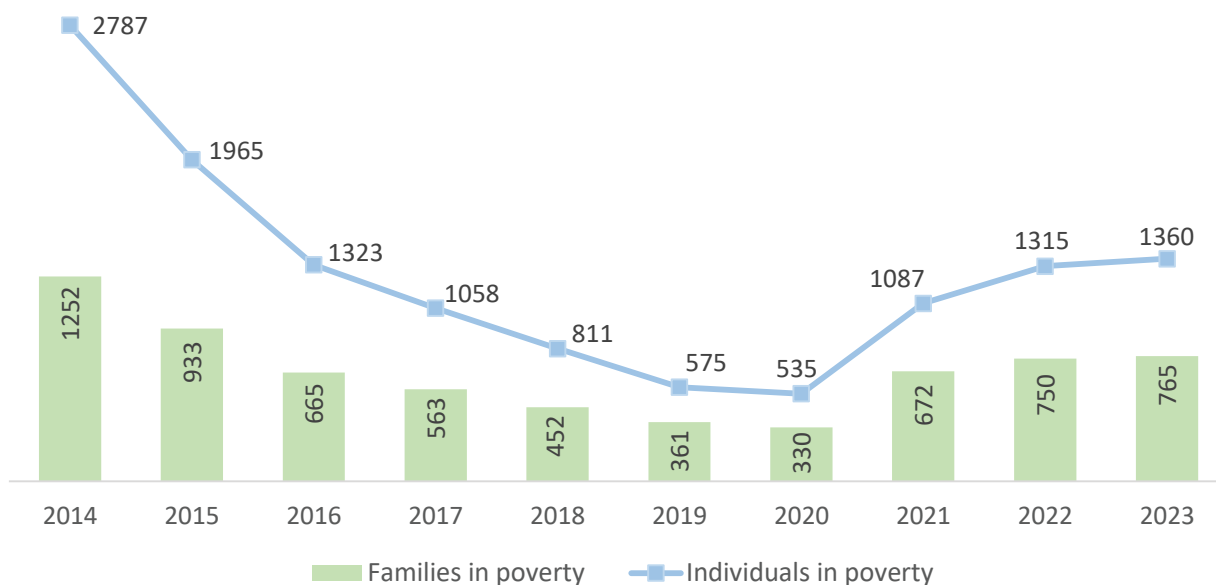

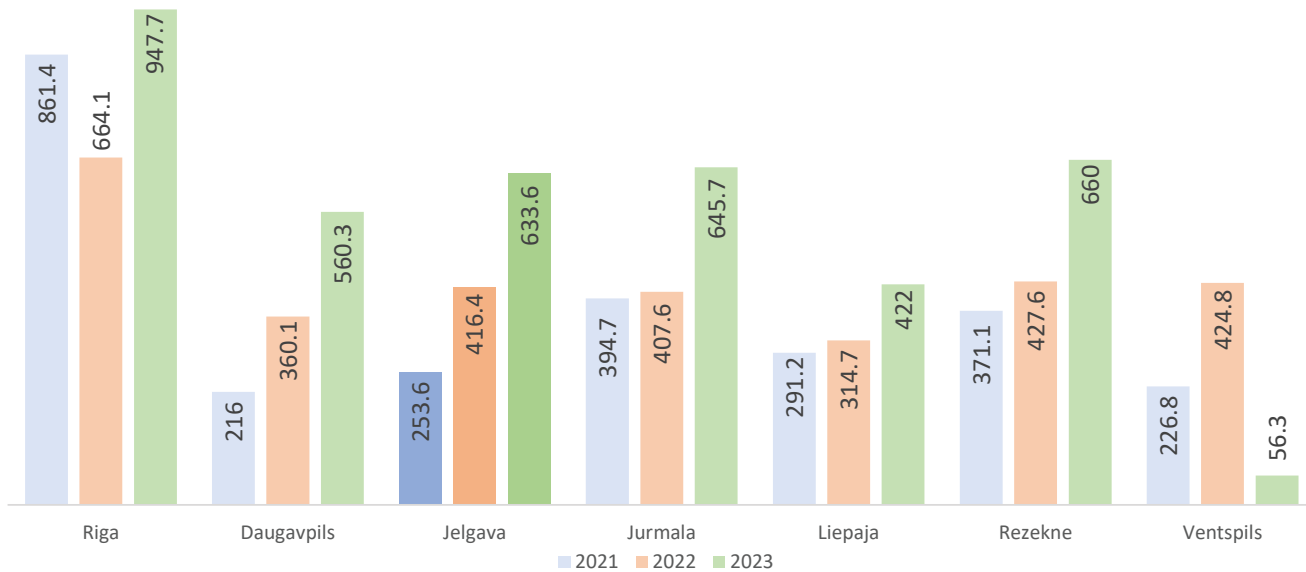

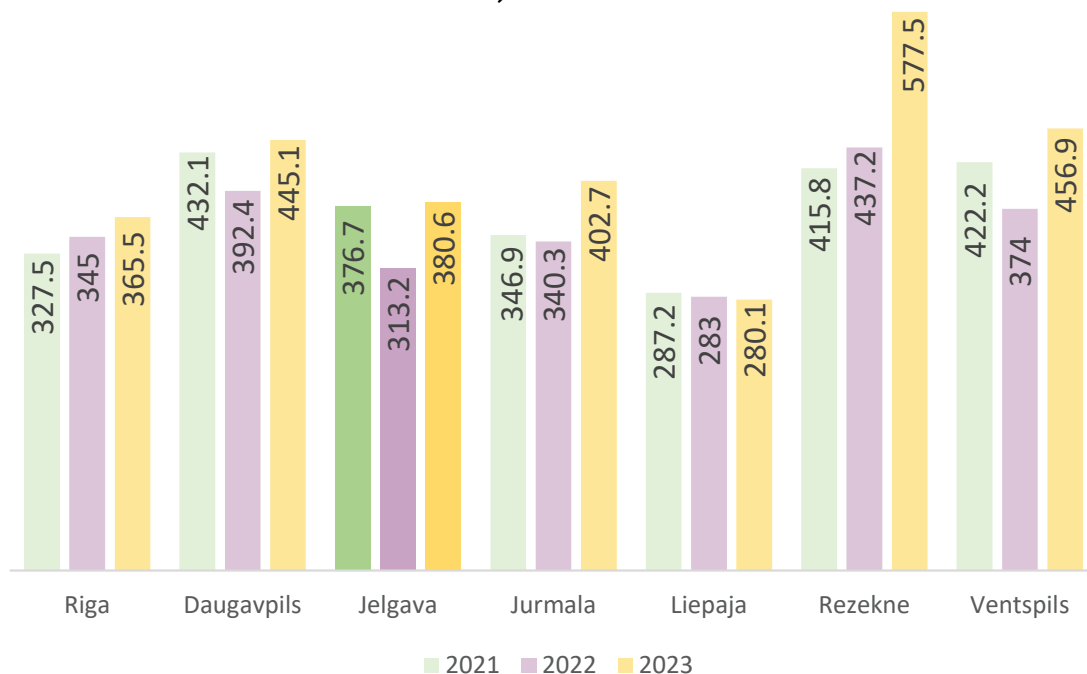


The average size of basic municipal social benefits per person per year, euro, 2021-2023

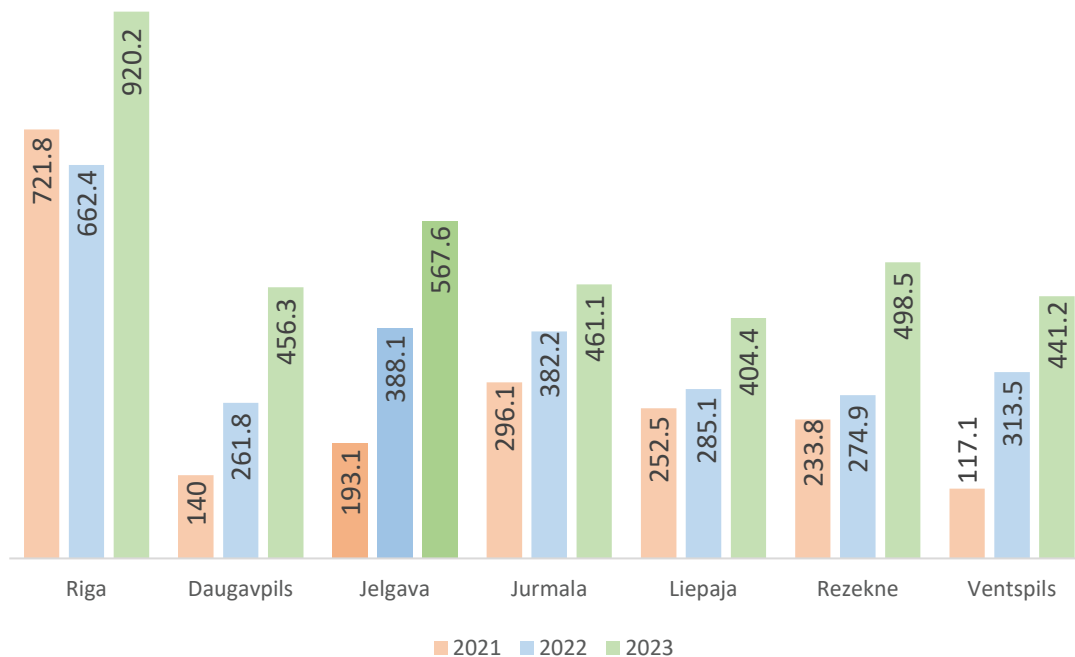
Guaranteed minimum income benefit in national cities per person per year, euro, 2021-2023

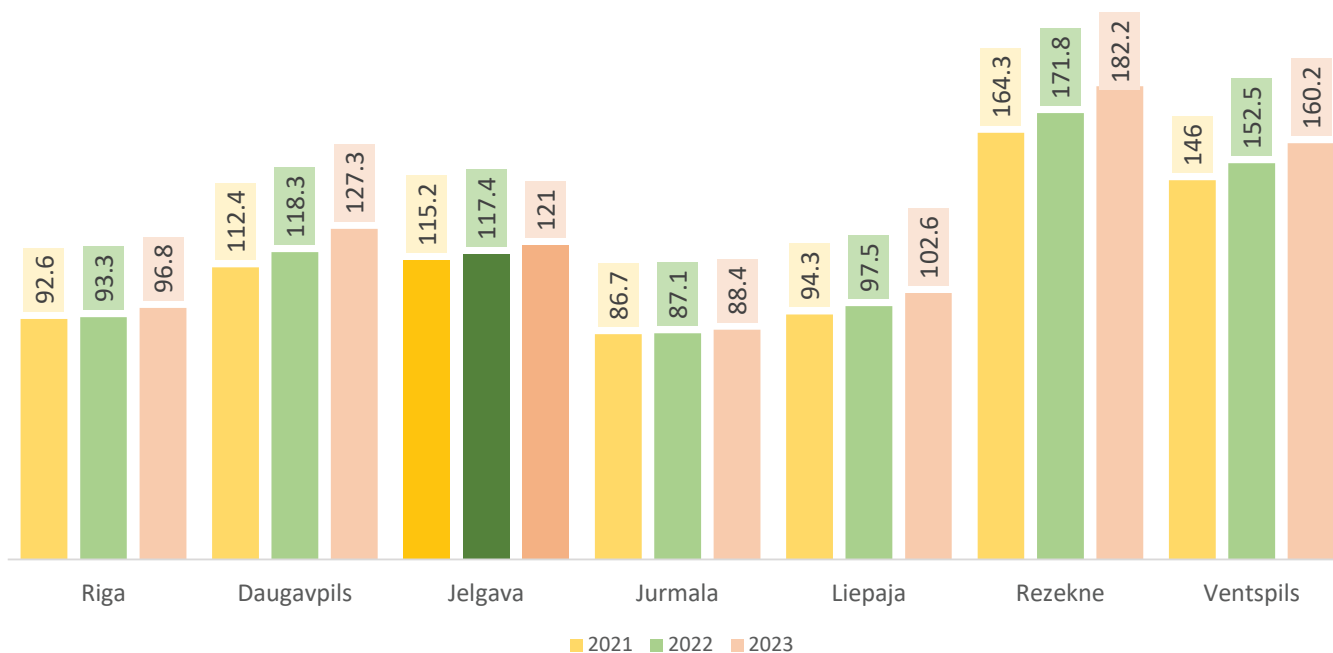


Housing benefit in national cities per person per year, euro, 2021-2023

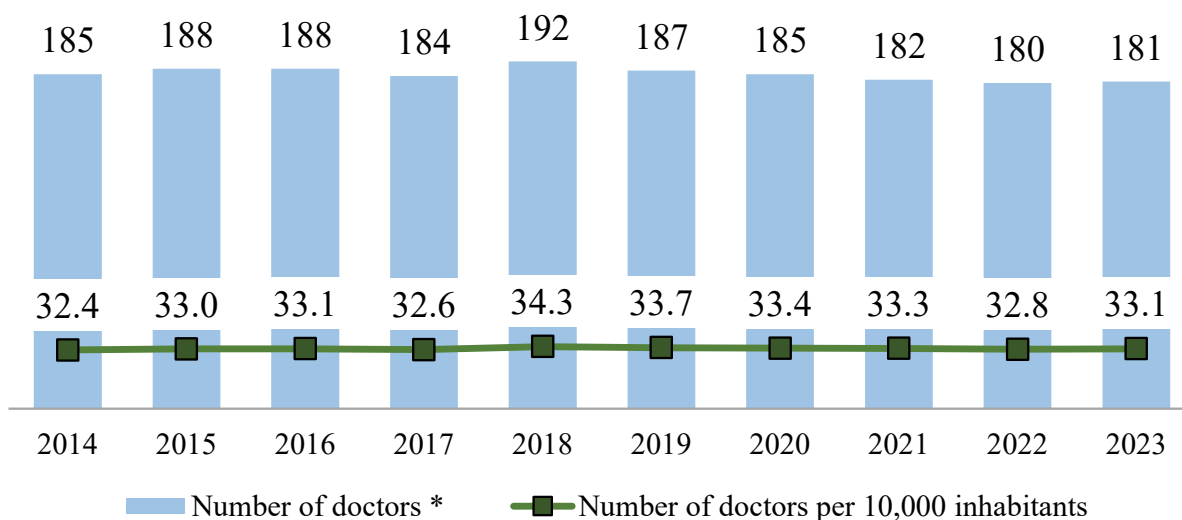

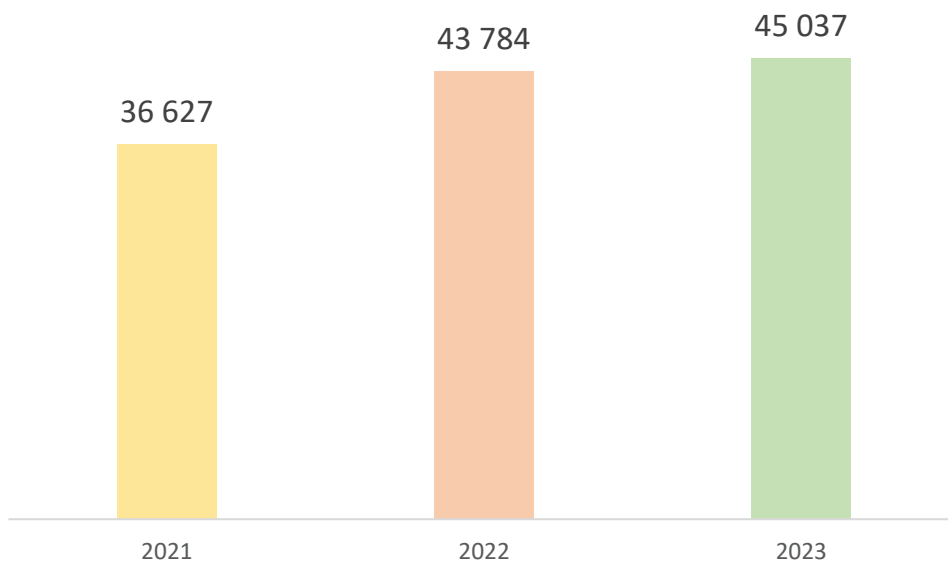

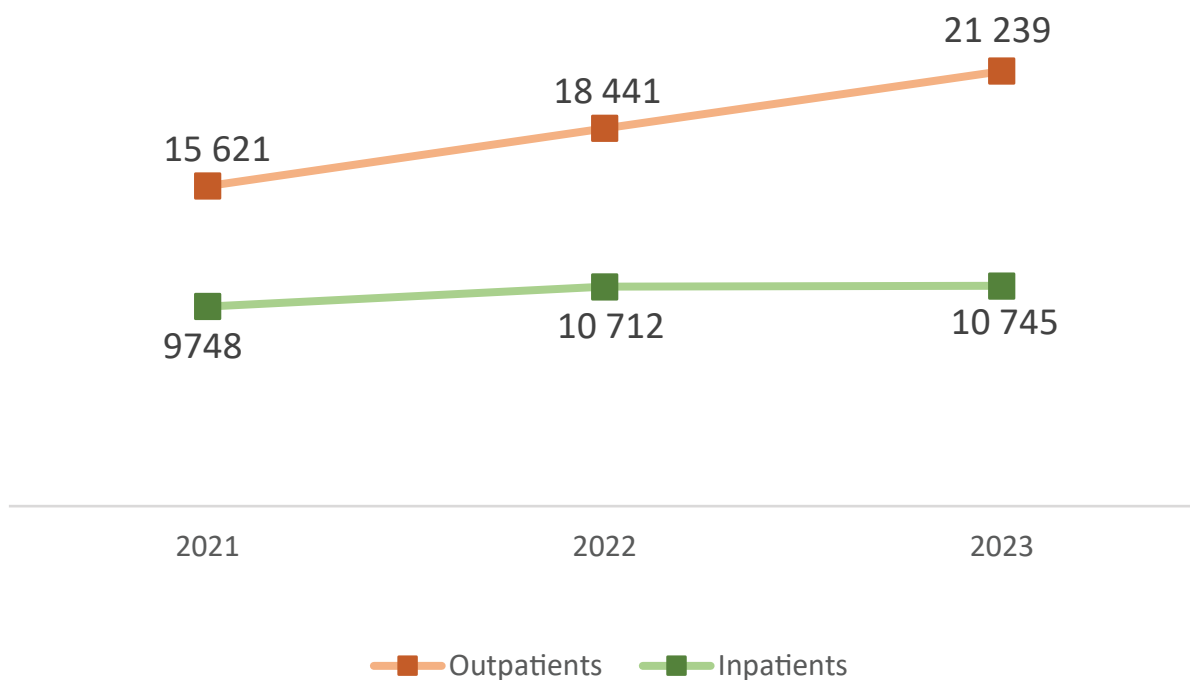


Outpatient health care - number of patients in Jelgava city hospital 2021-2023

Emergency medical assistance - the number of patients of the reception department in Jelgava City Hospital 2021-2023

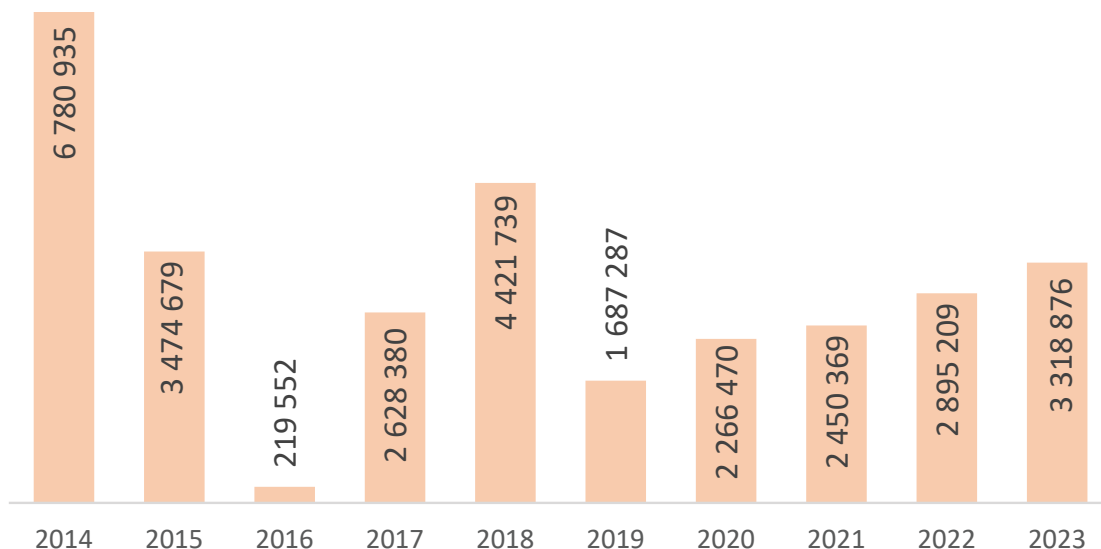

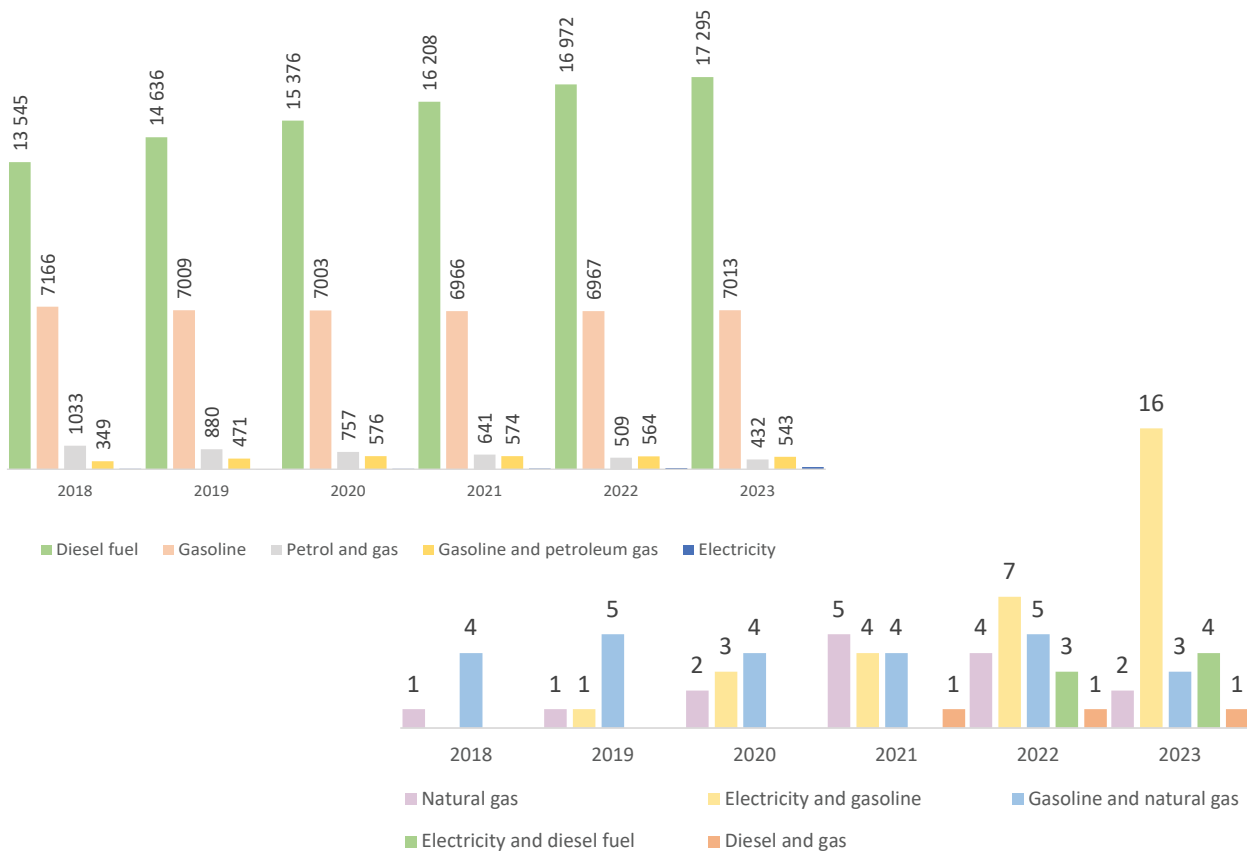

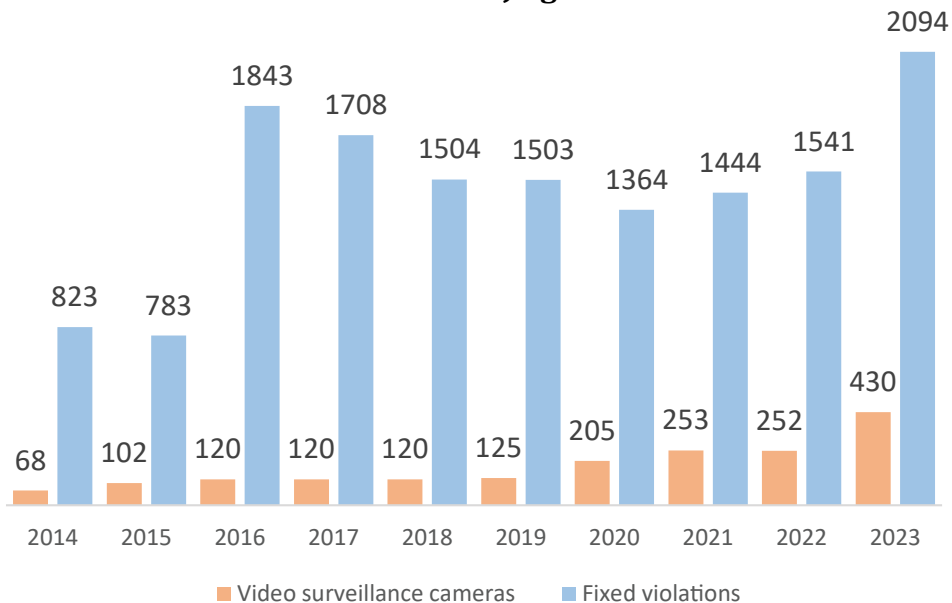
Number of vehicles in Jelgava by type of energy source 2018-2023

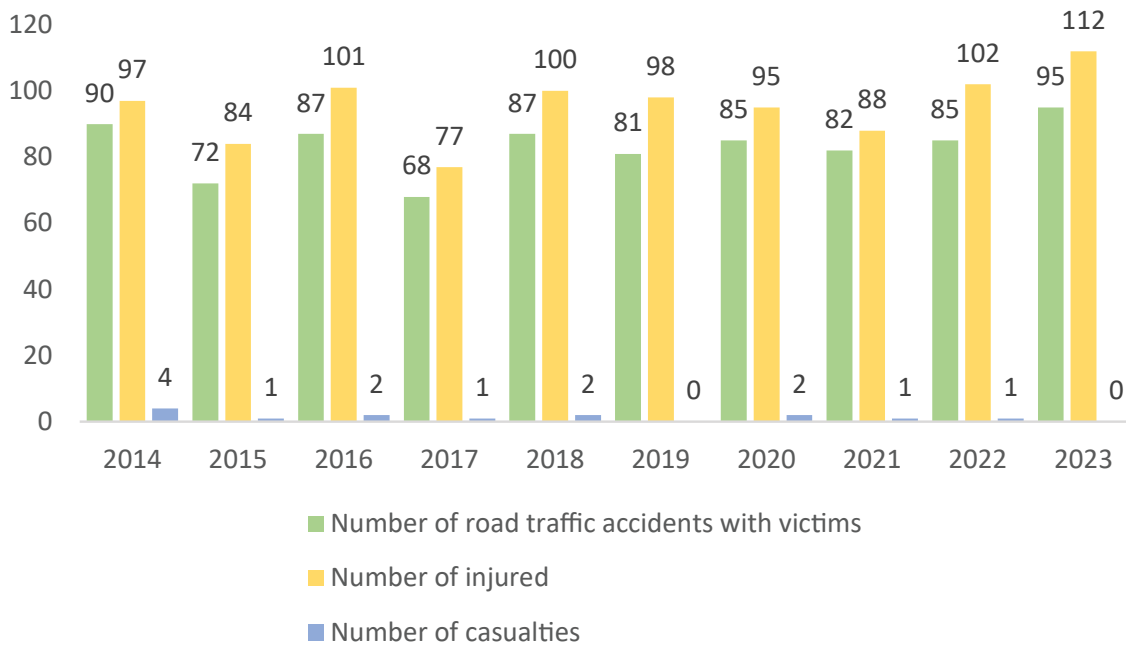


Video surveillance in Jelgava 2014-2023

Statistics of road traffic accidents in Jelgava 2014-2023

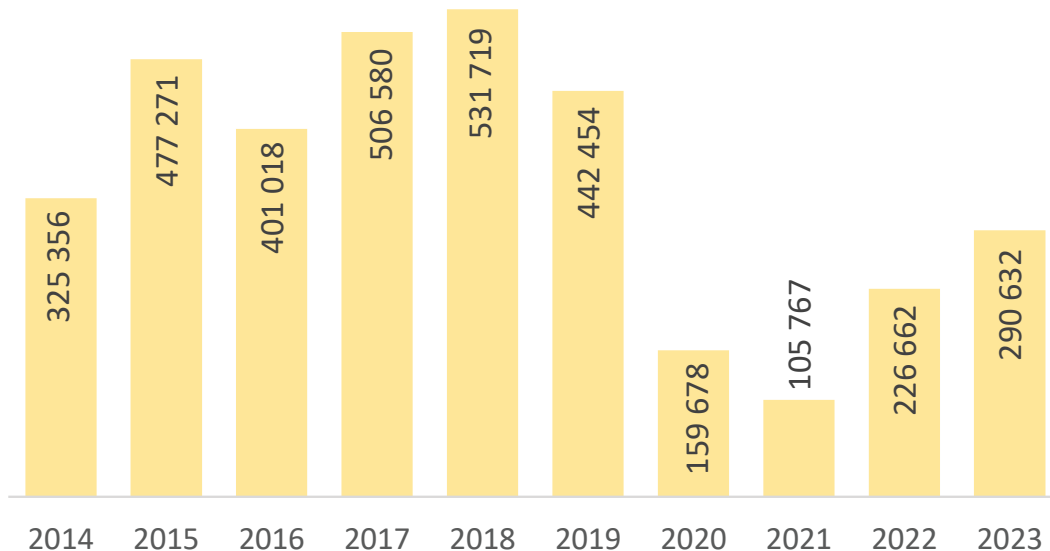

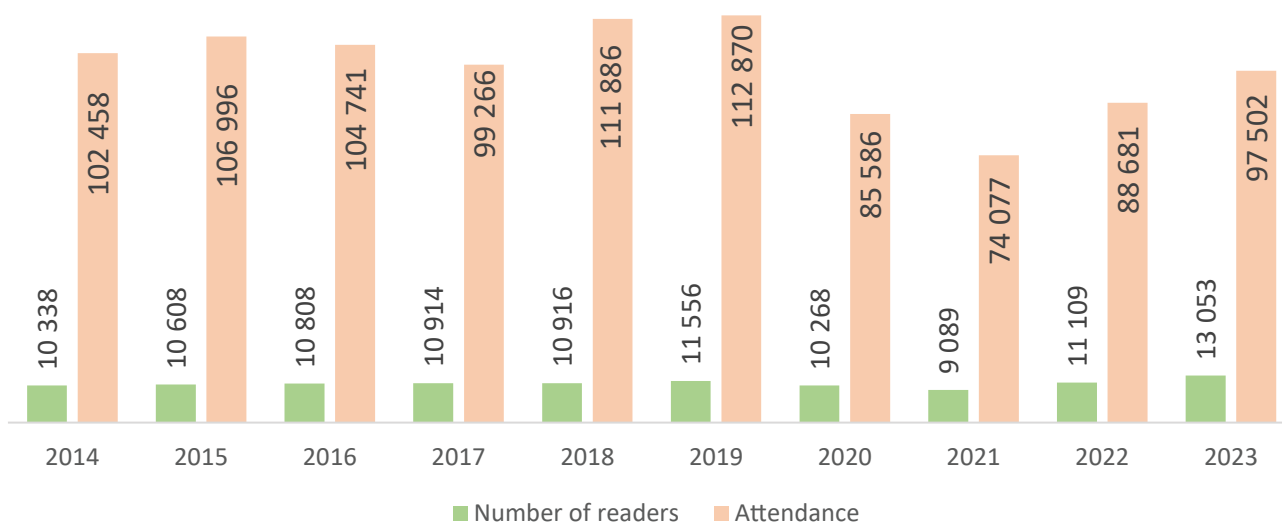

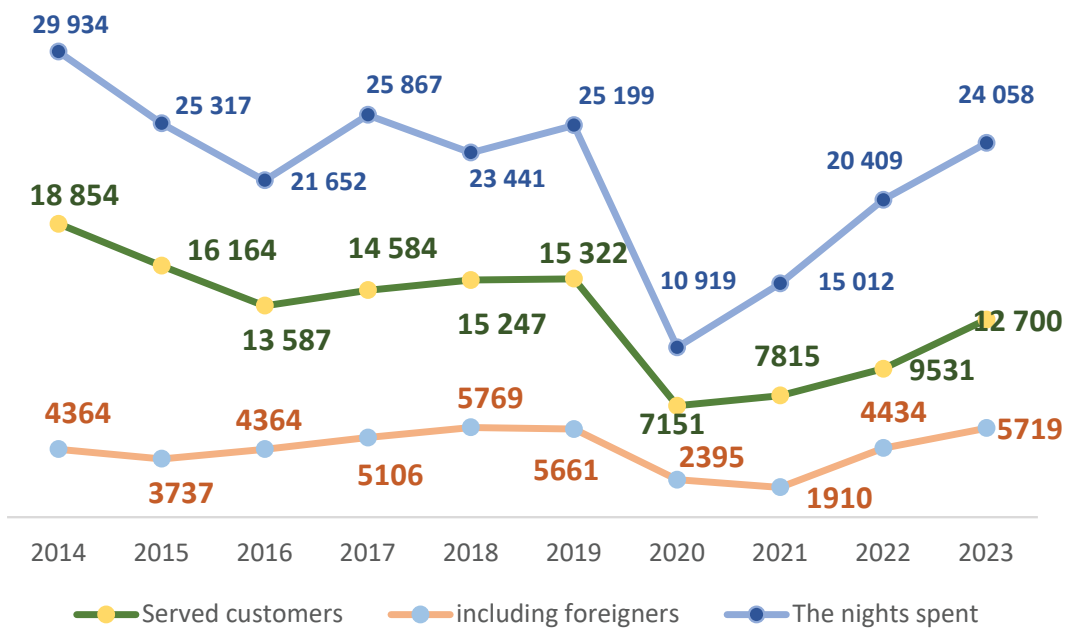
Number of readers and visits to Jelgava City libraries 2014-2023

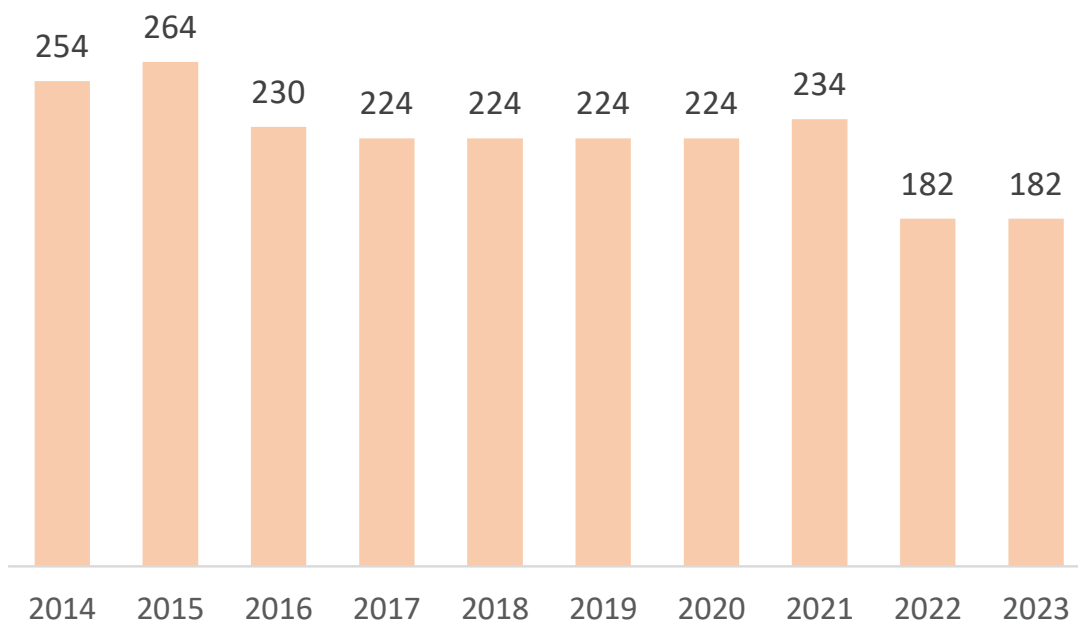


Data of persons staying in Jelgava accommodation 2014-2023

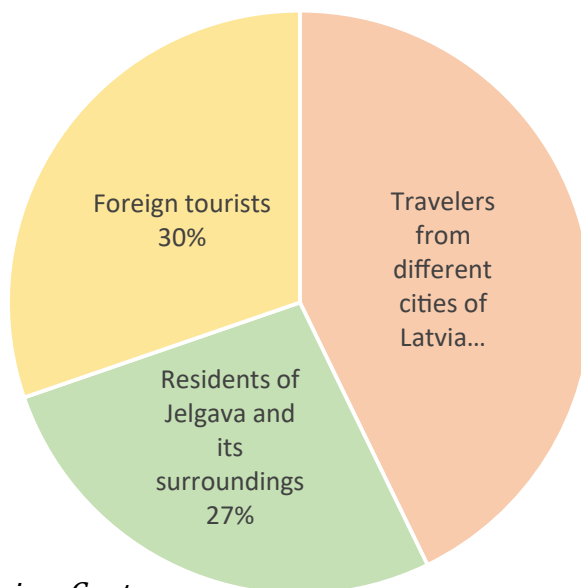

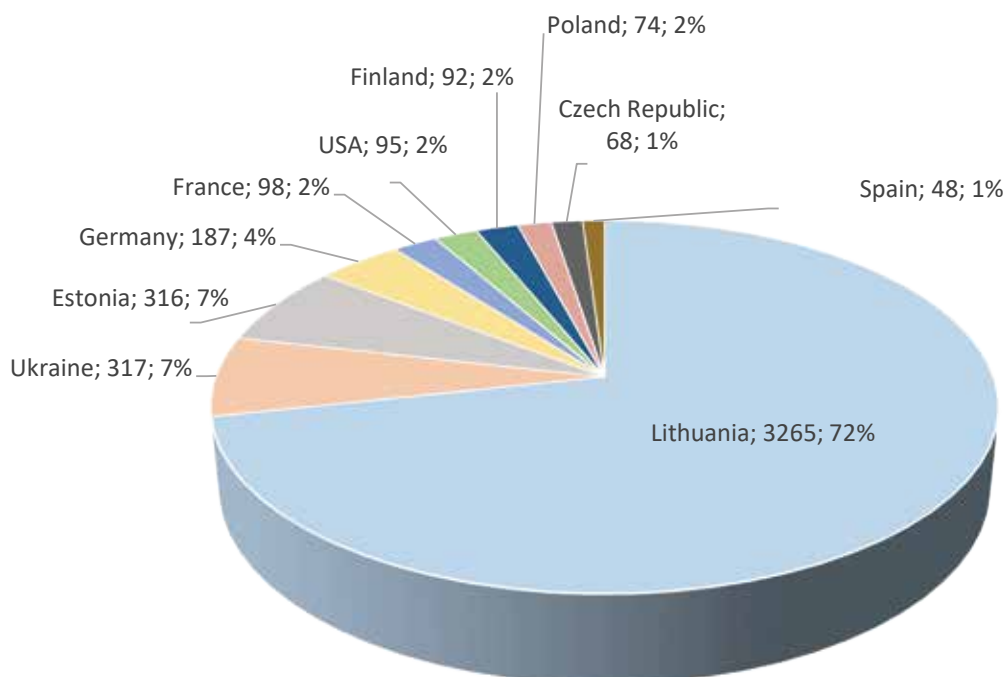

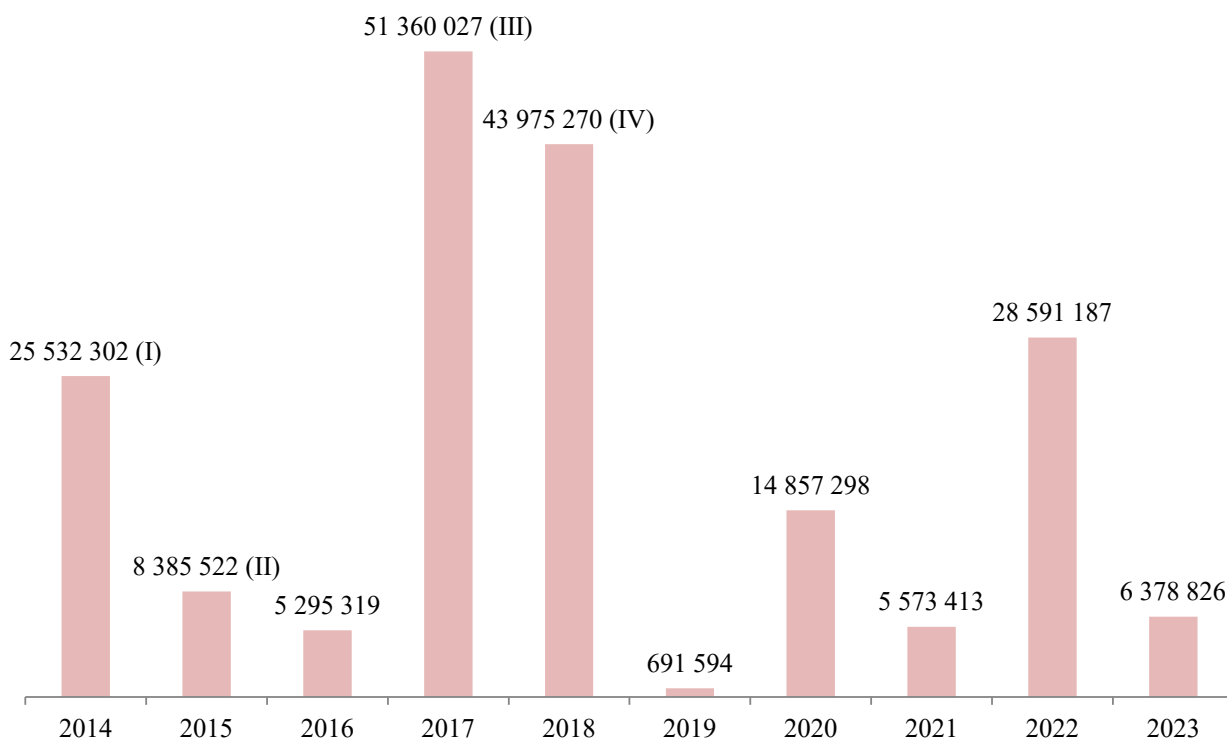
